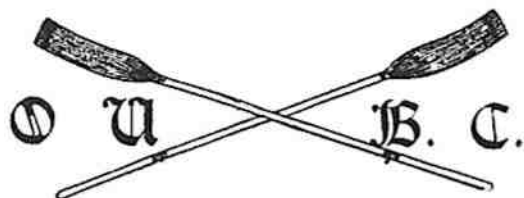

PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS

Bumping races are something quite unique. Crews race line astern with the sole intention of catching the boat in front of them. If success entails destroying the bows of their eight or the stern of their opponent's, then so be it. Over a thousand oarspersons will be participating in Summer Eights this week; all will have dedicated many hours to training and will hopefully have enjoyed the ordeal.

The past year has been a good one for University rowing. The women's Blue Boat, under the presidency of Leo Sharpston, performed magnificently after a year of total commitment and beat their Cambridge opponents by 2½ lengths at Henley. Osiris, the women's second eight, and the University Lightweights were both unlucky to lose close-fought races.

There were fears that the Boat Race would be yet another procession, as it has been over the past few years thanks to Oxford's dominance. It turned out, however, to be one of the closest races in the history of the event. Approaching the bandstand Oxford led by 2½ lengths and looked comfortable. But unbeknown to the rest of the crew their bowman, who had given his all and was subsequently found to have been suffering from hepatitis, collapsed and effectively stopped rowing. With Cambridge, to their credit, gaining with every stroke, Oxford's seven men hauled themselves across the line to win by a mere canvas. Isis, who were on occasions almost as fast as the Blue Boat, raced with great aggression to secure their first victory over Goldie in four years. They should feel proud of their success, which bodes well for next year.

We look forward to good results at Henley this summer, where Oxford will be represented by the winning Isis eight, the University Lightweights, Cherwell and perhaps the best College crews. For the moment, it is hoped that spectators and competitors alike will enjoy this year's Summer Eights, and join me in thanking everyone involved in its organisation.

The successes of the past year were due in large part to the enthusiastic and efficient organisation of the President, Boris Rankov. I thank him and look forward to an equally successful year.

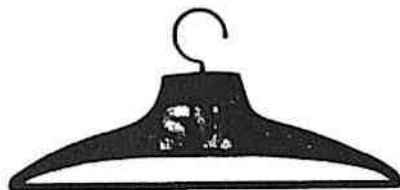

OXFORD WOMEN HIT TIMES FRONT PAGE!!

— Perhaps Cambridge wished they'd been better informed!

On Sunday 23rd March at Henley on Thames the Oxford Women's Blue Boat beat Cambridge impressively over a 2000 metre course. After the previous three year's defeats, this year's victory came as the first reward for the tremendous amount of effort put in by many people determined to see Oxford women's rowing as the "Force to be reckoned with."

Our crew steamed away from Cambridge off the start and settled well, never giving Cambridge any real chance to come back. They cruised over to finish 2½ lengths ahead.

Osiris, the University women's second crew, produced the most closely fought race of the day, attacking Blondie all the way, who managed to pull away only in the last minute.

Our success this year owed a lot to the long-distance training on the Radley stretch under the watchful eyes of Ronnie Howard and to the superb coaching of Len Andrews during the last three weeks before the race.

I should like to thank Boris Rankov and the rest of OUBC for their vital support in several areas, particularly in lending us a boat. Also, thanks to St. Catz, who lent us a new shell VIII for Osiris to row in, and to all those other Colleges who helped us both financially and with equipment.

— Congratulations to Leo Sharpston for leading the club to an excellent victory this year.

And so to the future: with the continually improving standards of women's college rowing and the increasing numbers of women becoming involved we should have the firm base we need. OUWBC draws its main strength from women who have learnt to row in Oxford, and next year's success will depend on people who are rowing in summer VIII's *now* — this may, of course, include you . . .

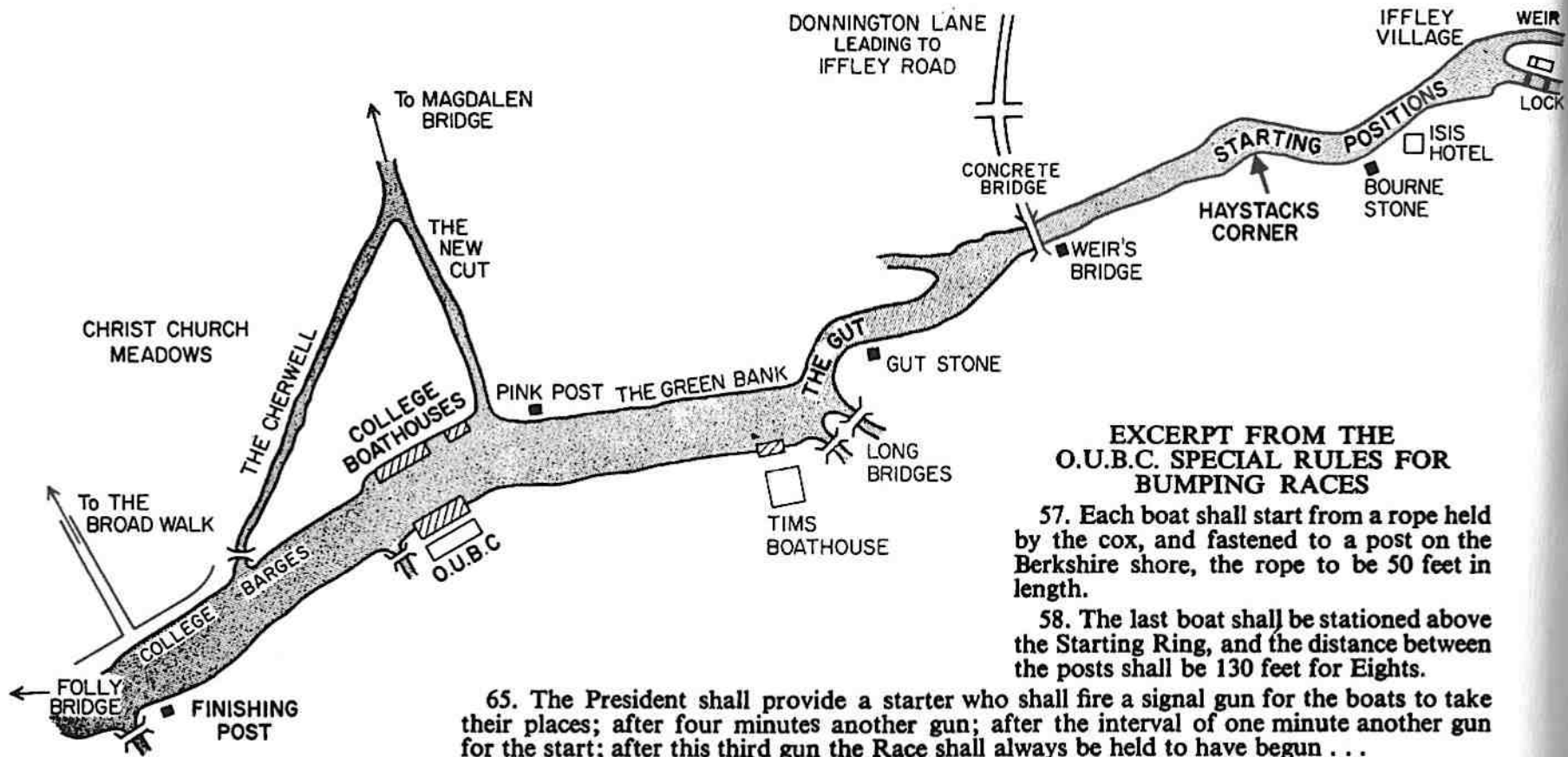

**EXCERPT FROM THE
O.U.B.C. SPECIAL RULES FOR
BUMPING RACES**

57. Each boat shall start from a rope held by the cox, and fastened to a post on the Berkshire shore, the rope to be 50 feet in length.

58. The last boat shall be stationed above the Starting Ring, and the distance between the posts shall be 130 feet for Eights.

65. The President shall provide a starter who shall fire a signal gun for the boats to take their places; after four minutes another gun; after the interval of one minute another gun for the start; after this third gun the Race shall always be held to have begun . . .

67. When a boat touches any part of the boat in front of it, or its oars or rudder, it shall be considered a bump, and also if a boat rows clean by another it shall be equivalent to a bump.

69. After every bump the boat bumping shall change places with the boat bumped whatever be their order before starting.
