





PRESIDENTS REPORT

1985 has been a historical year for the University Boat Club.

For those that do not know, Oxford beat Cambridge in the Boat Race to record our longest ever winning sequence of ten consecutive victories. One member of the Oxford crew, Bruce Philp of Worcester already had a Blue from Cambridge and thus became the first man to be awarded a Blue at both universities for rowing. He has also been elected, by the College Captains, to the office of President for the 1986 Boat Race.

As ex-President, Graham Jones, said in his report last year to the outside observer, Oxford's winning of the Boat Race may have a certain inevitability about it. If that were the case (and with the exception of one or two years, I know it has not been so) then the outcome of the 1985 Boat Race was anything but inevitable with Cambridge producing what was probably their strongest crew of the last decade. This years Boat Race will, I hope, be remembered not only as the 'tenth in a row' for Oxford, but also as a great victory after an extremely hard, well fought race.

The Oxford Isis crew, stroked by Chris Bourne, and captained by Donald Macdonald, rowed superbly well on the day, defeating Goldie by some 18 seconds and equalling the course record of 17 minutes and 36 seconds for the Isis/Goldie race.

These results are the product of an enormous amount of hard work and time. Though it is always up to the crews themselves on the day to produce their best ever form, we owe a great deal to everyone else who has helped us, throughout the year, to realise ambitions and potential and to make the chance of success that much greater. My thanks for this year's race go to the Blue Boat coaches, headed by Dan Topolski, the Isis coaches headed by Keith Mason and to the numerous coaches who braved the pot holes of the towpath in Michaelmas term. I would also like to thank Ladbrokes for their continuing sponsorship of the event, to County Dairies for their daily pinta and the many other sponsors who have helped us.

For much help with the day to day running of the Club, I must thank Chris Bourne and Seth Lesser and Ian Tatchell. Thanks also to Michael Barry, the OUBC Treasurer, Albert Andrews for his continuing service, the OUBC Trust Fund, Jim Railton and his staff at the Sports Centre, Anne Blacket, physio extraordinaire, the T.W.A. for being so patient with us, Morag Simpson of OUWBC (well done), Alex

Bird of OULPC and the OUBC committee of Dave Aeron Thomas, Pip Mason, Leslie Clare, Dave Foster and Juliet Vickery.

Finally may I wish everyone, especially the College Captains, the best of luck for a successful Eights week and urge you to enter yourselves for the OUBC Cherwell trials after Eights and to try and take your college crews to Henley Royal Regatta on 4th July.

President's Report

OXFORD UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BOAT CLUB

The 1985 Blue Boat was the most experienced and talented crew to emerge from the Isis in recent years. It proved to be the most successful too.

For once, we arrived in Henley as favourites for the big race. Preparation had gone well. We had won the University Pennant at the Women's Eights Head, finishing as top non-ARA crew, and the women's title at Reading Head. But we knew we were in for a hard race.

In the strong wind aligning the boats was difficult. As the umpires flag went down we were too close and clashed blades within 3 or 4 strokes. Suffering more than Cambridge from the clash we found ourselves a length down after 2 mins. However as the race progressed we gradually decreased the deficit. Despite further blade clashes we finally rowed Cambridge down to win by 3½ seconds.

It was a day of double celebrations, with Osiris winning the reserves race too. A severe blade clash at Remenham caused the umpire to stop the race. Restarted ¾ length down, Osiris powered through Blondie and went on to win by 8 seconds.

The Lightweight crew found their opposition just too strong. Cambridge pulled away from the start and won easily.

The Boat Race victory ended Cambridge's run of 3 wins. they will definitely be out for revenge next year but we intend to keep the trophy in Oxford. All but one of this years crew learned to row in Oxford. Good college rowers always form the basis of the OUWBC squad and we are already looking for oarswomen and coxes for the 1986 Boat Race crews. The 'Windrush' crews selected in 6th week are aimed at new trialists and provide valuable racing experience at a number of regattas including The National Championships. Details of Windrush trials will be announced over the tannoy this week.

Reflecting on the glory I must thank those who made it possible. The dedicated team of coaches led by Nigel Mayglothling, the boatmen who helped keep us afloat, Bill Parry, The Trust Fund and Jim Railton for financial assistance and of course Lynton Richmond and The OUBC for all their support. We are particularly grateful to all the college Boat Clubs who lent us equipment.

Finally I wish OUWBC continued success next year under new President Tish Reid, and to everyone


competing in Eights, the very best of luck.

BRAZIL TOUR 1985

QUESTION: What do Pina Coladas, Transvestites, Montezuma's revenge and Ronald Biggs all have in common?

JOLLY BOATING WEATHER

Rowing brings out the best in one, or does it? In defence of the proposition a good oarsman (oarswoman) has to do two things simultaneously: concentrate on improving individual technique while synchronising one's effort with others. Thereby avoiding the self-centredness of cricket (pace the landlubbers) where personal averages matter so much. Nor does the obsession with rowing ever quite desert one. When Lord Desborough, one of the greatest all-round athletes and Oxford Rowing Blues of all time, was talking to one he used to flick his wrist at the end of a sentence as if he was finishing a stroke, clean, crisp and strong. Involuntary movements gave away his pastime.

A good stroke must not only have leadership, drive and inspiration, but a sound reliable rhythm, the very prerequisite of cohesion and togetherness in a crew. Musicians and poets have rhythm, and have sometimes made excellent strokes. Dick Holdsworth (First in Law, and Dean of 'Univ') was as compelling on the piano as stroking a crew. David Winser of Corpus, who stroked Oxford in the Boat Race, also won the University Prize for poetry, the Newdigate prize for English verse. Yehudi Menuhin

may not have rowed, but would have imparted rhythm, if nothing else.

One of the most famous strokes, R.C. Bourne, not content with stroking Oxford to victory against Cambridge in four successive years, went on to become Deputy Speaker in the House of Commons, virtually stroking members into submission or surrender by a dexterous authority derived from . . . no, I

must not exaggerate. But he knew how to control.

As for coxes, they steer all sorts of courses. One married the sister of the Queen. A recent cox, C. Moynihan, is now an M.P., and coxed the British national VIII to 5th place in the Los Angeles Olympics during the Summer recess. One pocket-edition of a cox, H.P.V. Massey, of Balliol, was so light at 5 stone 2 lbs, that his weight in the stern sometimes failed to keep the rudder in the water sufficiently to execute a turn. On one occasion he failed to get through Barnes Bridge, heading straight for the bank, but that is another story.

Of course, times have changed in other respects. Outings no longer end with stowing a boat away in the O.U.B.C., walking all the way up the towpath to one's College barge, waiting for the boatman to bring the punt across, pulling a chain to release cold, cold water over yourself while you stand in a tin tub, and emerge tingling with rude health. Mr. Best, the much respected, white-bearded ferryman, allowed no slipshod language in his punt and expected personal behaviour of a high order in his presence.

Gone are the days when Bishops were recruited, seemingly, from the ranks of Rowing Blues, and the

Welsh Marches were protected by the Rowing Blue Bishops of Chester, Lichfield and Gloucester. The entire Oxford crew of the first Boat Race took Holy Orders, and ended up as Bishops, Deans, Prebendaries, and the like — no nepotism, just merit!

As for today, prowess on the river is not divorced from academic expectation. Many an oarsman (oarswoman), 'I like to take my exercise sitting down,' sets his sights on post-graduate work, a D.Phil.,

lecturing or research, and a goodly number succeed.

Far be it from me to extol the virtues of oarsmen too far, but a recent memory justifies it all. Danuta Shanzer of Corpus, who rowed for Oxford against Cambridge in 1979, is now Assistant Professor of Classics in the University of California in Berkeley. But at the Ninth International Conference on Patristic Studies in Oxford last September, dressed overall with dignity in episcopal purple, she mesmerised her audience with a brilliant paper on 'The death of Boethius and the Consolation of Philosophy'. The Chairman, Dean of Christ Church and Regius Professor of Divinity, whipped out his pen and made copious notes in honour of an outstanding piece of work.

The case is proved. Rowing can do no lasting harm. Individual progress, put to the benefit of the

community, owes something to early training on the river. 'So we'll all swing together . . .'
