### THE NEW ROWING CENTRE

Since 1989, and the launch of the OUBC 150th Anniversary Appeal, over £380,000 has been donated. Oxford rowing now boasts a new rowing centre at the University Sports Centre, Iffley Road, containing an indoor rowing facility and a high-tec gymnasium specially equipped for rowers. Phase I of the £500,000 project is now complete.

Phase II - the building of a new boat house is still short of just over £100,000, in spite of a magnificent donation from the PF Charitable Trust in memory of Philip Fleming, founder of Robert Fleming & Company Limited. As a result of this generous donation, the new boat house will carry the Fleming name.

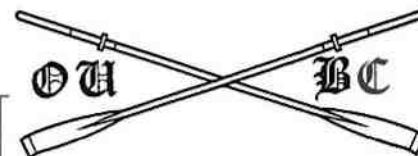

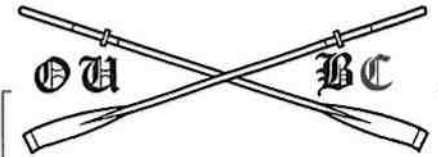

## *Oxford University Women's Boat Club*

Ouwbc started training at the beginning of Michaelmas Term with a squad of 25, most of whom had taken part in the previous summer's development squad, which sent crews to Women's Henley and the National Championships. After a few weeks on the Isis, and a win in Senior 3 at the Four's Head, the squad moved to Abingdon to continue training in fours. Trips to Tiffin and Marlow Heads were very successful, with Ouwbc fours winning Senior 1, 2 and 3 at both events. 'Equal' eights raced at Bristol University Head at the end of term, with one crew taking Senior 1.

Trial eights races were held at the end of tenth week after a week's training camp in Henley. 'Stardust' beat 'Glitter' by one length, while a third eight lost to the Women's Lightweights top crew.

The squad reassembled at Kingston Rowing Club after the Christmas break for another week's training camp. Despite the steadily worsening river conditions, all the seat racing was completed, and at the end of the week the first outings were held in provisional Blue Boat and Osiris crews.

Unfortunately, all the rivers in Oxfordshire were by now closed, and water work was moved to the Tideway for the next couple of weeks. The crews then moved to Wallingford, with regular visits to Henley to familiarise both coxes and crew with the race course.

Fixtures were held against Bedford, Weybridge, the Women's Lightweights, Thames Tradesmen and University of London to increase everyone's side-by-side race experience. The Blue Boat were particularly pleased to beat University of London, who had beaten Cambridge the previous weekend.

At the Henley Boat Races on March 20th, Osiris started very well, leading Blondie through the halfway point by three-quarters of a length. However Blondie pushed back and managed to row through them to win by a canvas.

In the Women's Boat Race, sponsored for the first time by Beefeater Gin, Cambridge were expected to have a fast start, and they did, taking a length in the first 500m. Our carefully planned push at Upper Thames never materialised, and we lost by a length, the whole crew disappointed by our poor performance.

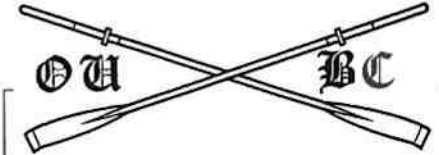

## *Summer Eights 1993*

Eights Week 1993, saw **Oriel** heavily fancied to retain the headship with a crew consisting of one Blue and no less than five Isis oarsmen. However, a less than rigorous training schedule seemed to offer a well drilled **Pembroke VIII**, with one Blue and one Isis oarsman, a realistic chance to gain the headship. However, on the first day Oriel showed the form that would lead to them retaining the headship. On Thursday Pembroke closed to a length rating 40 in the gut but Oriel were five lengths clear at the finish.

Meanwhile in the Women's first division **Somerville** also continued their reign at the top, rowing comfortably clear of **Brasenose**, Pembroke and then Osler House who bumped University, B.N.C. and Pembroke to rise to 2nd.

On Friday Oriel again rowed over head well clear of **Pembroke**, while **Worcester** bumped up to sixth in place of **Balliol**, the only change in the top half of the division throughout Eights Week. This was their third bump having caught **New College** and **St John's** on the previous two days, Worcester's blades attempt being thwarted by **S.E.H.** on the Saturday.

At the foot of the women's first division Oriel gained their blades by bumping **L.M.H.**, **St. Hilda's**, **Wolfson** and **St. Catherine's**. This was the only set of blades won in either of the first divisions.

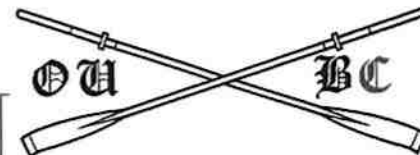
On the last day **Oriel** rowed over so easily that they included a 10 second easy oar outside their boathouse and still finished 5 lengths clear.

In the men's second division **St. Peter's** won their blades by bumping **St. Catherine's** on the final day, who had narrowly avoided being bumped by **Oriel II** the previous day.

## *Torpids 1994*

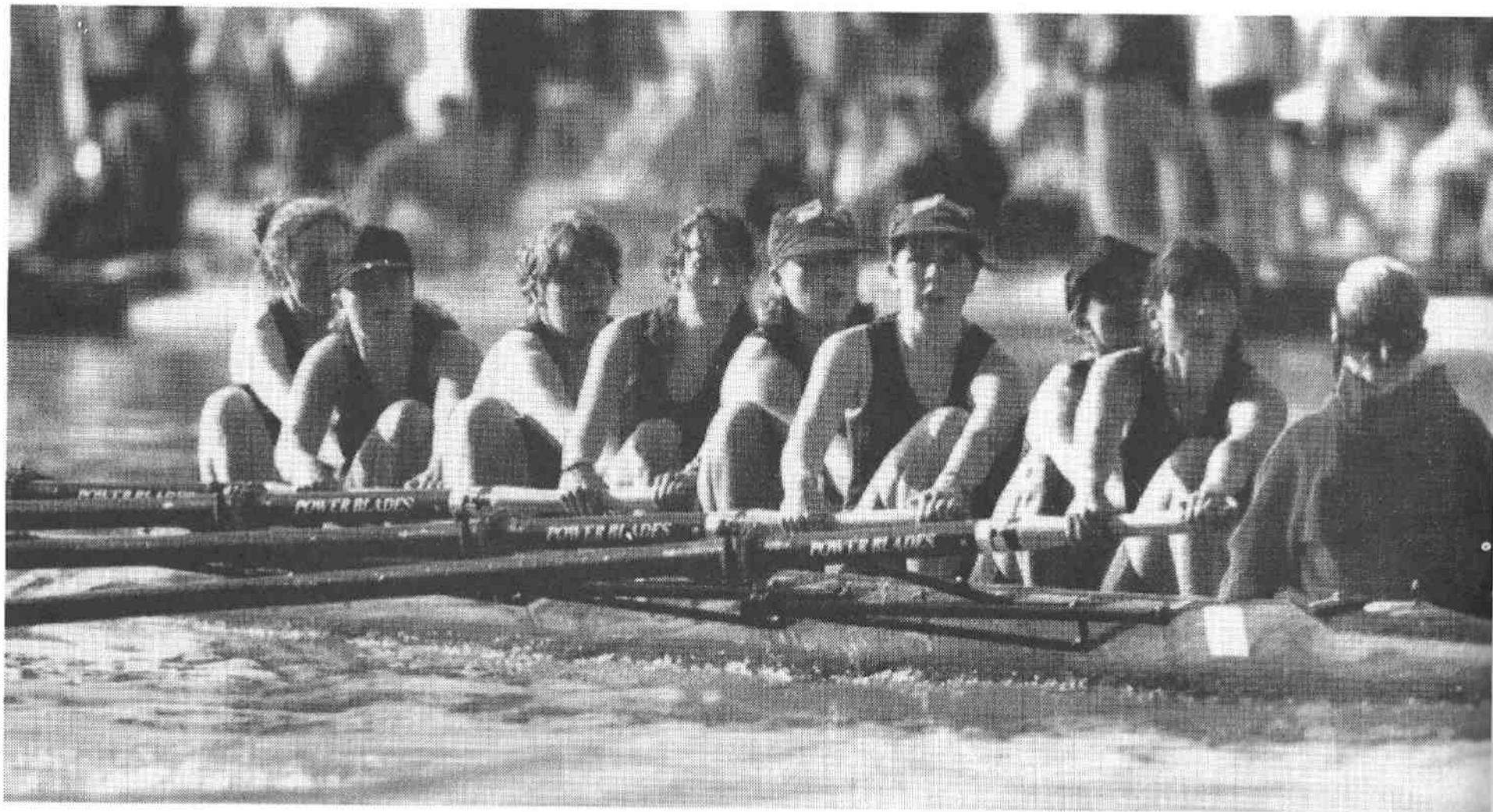

Rowing in Hilary Term this year was, yet again, severely hampered by the weather. Floods, having already disrupted much training, caused the complete cancellation of the last three days of Torpids. Those races that did proceed, on Wednesday, went far from smoothly. A pile up in the Men's Fourth Division delayed all divisions thereafter. The ensuing rush to make up for lost time was responsible for a feast of technical bumps that subsequently rather spoiled the Women's First Division. Despite this haste the Men's First Division was rowed in semi-darkness.

**Oriel** successfully defended the Headship but, unsettled by illness, not with their customary ease. **Brasenose**, in second place, pushed them hard to finish just three-quarters of a length down. **Pembroke** and **S.E.H.** had particular cause to rue the weather's interference. Having bumped **University** and **New College** respectively they were then denied the opportunity to make the further progress one might have expected. On the other hand **Oriel II** will have had few regrets over the floods intervention; they dropped three places and start next year as sandwich boat. In the Men's Second Division **Hertford** and **Queen's** both suffered similar unhappy falls.

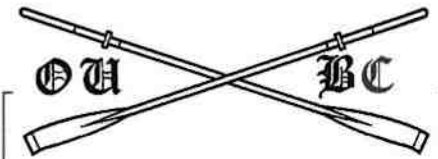
In the women's races **New College**, **University** and **St. Hilda's** were all penalized with technical bumps for not being on the bung-line in time. Since **New College** were starting second, **Somerville** were essentially unchallenged and retained the Headship without difficulty. The only genuine bump in the division was that of **Christ Church** on **Pembroke**.

## OUBC Ferry

Between divisions, the OUBC will operate a ferry from the OUBC boat house to the lower end of the college boat houses, on each night of Eights from 11.30 am until 20 minutes after the First Division has finished (or later if by agreement with the ferryman).

The use of the ferry is restricted to college crews, those assisting college boat clubs and those authorized by the OUBC officers with priority for the latter, and for coaches. No alcohol may be carried on the ferry. Coxes are asked to look out for the ferry and to steer clear of it, since the ferry will be used when the river appears empty.

No one may operate the ferry except those authorized by the OUBC. College boat clubs are responsible for the proper use of the ferry by their members. Ferrymen have discretion in deciding priority for passengers if necessary. The OUBC thanks ferrymen for their voluntary help.

## *Incoming Slides*

Eights Week, a symbol of the traditional English summer. Yet how traditional must it seem to spectators who have seen the event change so visibly in recent years? Carbon fibre blades, boats and the new fangled 'big blade' design – none of these were present even fifteen years ago. Their contribution to the aesthetics of the event is debatable but one should be careful in categorizing such relentless evolution as a lamentable symptom of the modern world. Indeed, when compared to the rowing revolution ongoing throughout the Victorian era, such fine tunings pale into insignificance.

The very first bumps races, in 1815, were rowed in huge boats of a design that had remained almost unchanged for fifty years. Their roominess is demonstrated by their occasional use in retirement, after internal refurbishment, as pleasure boat sixes seating a sociable twenty people – rather fewer if Victorian codes of intimacy were strictly observed. Gang planks persisted until landing stages rendered them unnecessary for getting into and out of the boat. By the turn of the century the racing boat had changed, almost beyond recognition, into lightweight eights of designs similar to those used today. College crews on the Isis were frequently among the first recipients of state-of-the-art boats applying principles conceived far from Carfax.

The early eights had inboard rowlocks, the oars supported by the actual body of the boat in a way familiar to rowing enthusiasts of the "come in number five, your time is up" variety. How could the bulk of these boats be significantly reduced whilst their width was thus dependant on the required leverage on the blade? The introduction of the outrigger solved the problem by allowing narrower, and hence lighter, boats for a given gearing. The idea was first pursued in 1828 but it was not until 1845 that Clasper, one of a string of pioneering Newcastle boat builders, was able to make it a practical reality. The first outriggers were folding for convenience in boat moving and storage. News travelled south quickly;

Exeter College are reputed to have heard via messenger pigeon. Be that as it may, the college was certainly the first to race with the new riggers in Eights 1846. Improvements in speed were not, at first, dramatic and indeed Exeter, claiming that their new boat had "proved an entire failure", returned to their previous one for the event of 1847. This damning judgement was made despite making two bumps with the new technology.

Another key development with its origins on the Tyne was the inboard keel. This design, giving a smooth bottomed hull, reduced friction and saved weight to an even greater extent than did the outrigger. Taylor, his claim on the hull's actual invention hotly disputed by many, worked tirelessly in his boatyard to divine optimum dimensions for the new boats. The ideal shape turned out to be shorter, by around ten feet, than that of the keeled boats of the day. Exeter, their bursary again demonstrating an exemplary understanding of boating requirements, bought the first keel-less boat in 1856 and by 1857 were joined in Eights by Oriel, Balliol, Pembroke and B.N.C. Initially met with some hostility, the new boats were not immediately adopted universally but improvements in speed ultimately proved impossible to ignore. Corpus Christi had their own reasons for using an old style eight as late as 1869. In that year their Torpid was technically inept to an extent that made balancing their keel-less eight entirely beyond them. Reverting to an intrinsically more stable keeled eight for racing was their solution, although their Chaplain noted that the crew appeared "not so proficient" even then. Taylor's careful calculations over optimal design were to go straight out of the window within twenty years following the introduction of the most revolutionary idea of them all – the sliding seat.

Experiment with the sliding seat principle had occurred as early as the eighteen-fifties in various places but the problem of building a reliable prototype seemed insoluble. A practical design even eluded the normally inventive Geordies; their only contribution to research involved



lubricating seat and trousers with lard and slipping about a bit. The French invented trousers specially made for the task – fashionable, but ultimately irrelevant. The introduction of a seat sliding on metal runners came from America. The lard was now applied to these runners alone and cleaning costs were dramatically reduced. The new boat was now a sensible reality but few were immediately impressed:

*Ample experiment have I endured with the floating seat and its merits I account but few. Convincing are the hypotheses of our theoreticians but I foresee no triumph of these putative efficiencies over the multitude of problems technical and mechanical associated with its application. And my legs hurt.*

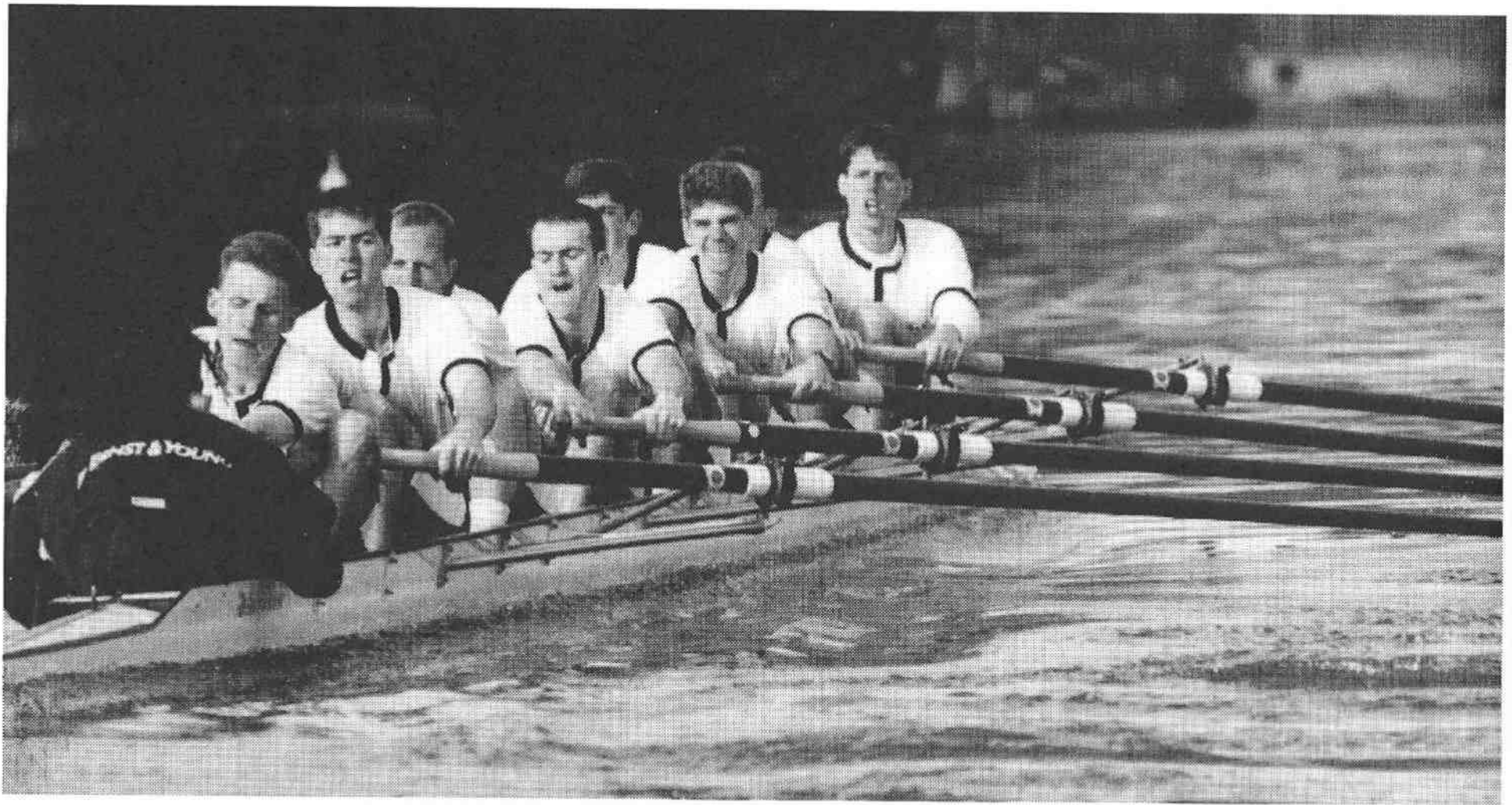
What made this modification particularly dramatic was that an entirely new stroke was required. Considering it took decades for consensus over the new technique to be reached, one shudders to think of the styles on display during Eights Week 1873 when sliding seats were first used. Mr. Strawson's comments are made in the light of this confusing period on the river. It was some years before footplate design complemented that of the new seats. Strapless and rather overlooked in fixed seat boats their vertical orientation was wholly inappropriate to the leg compression required in the new stroke. Calf strains were a common complaint. The sloping footplate was soon introduced to help this problem. It is to be hoped that Mr. Strawson obtained relief.

No further demonstration of the efficacy of the sliding seat was required after Eights 1873. Exeter, electing at first to stick with what they knew, dropped five places in three nights before fitting slides. On the final day Keble, after a similar about turn in equipment, succeeded in rebumping the same St. Mary Hall crew that had caught them earlier in the week. Slides were here to stay but experiment with their design was far from over. Early models, using bone runners on brass, were prone to stick even when using copious quantities of grease and oil. Glass rods were a popular alternative around 1875 but, painfully predictable, they were fragile and indeed New College managed to break four in a single race. Polished gas pipes were a robust replacement but use of wheels and vulcanite runners took over in 1885.

Was rowing powerless to prevent these dramatic Victorian changes? Modern parallel suggests not; several novel boat designs have actually been banned from competition internationally by the powers that be. In particular the sliding rigger, used to great effect by certain scullers in the early nineteenth century, was subsequently banned on the grounds that it imposed an unreasonable expense on poorer clubs. Similar justification was given for the outlaw of several drag reducing hull designs. The attitude seems inconsistent with that of the equivalent authorities when confronted with similar developments last century. However, considering how much Eights has changed since 1815, consistency of any sort would seem to be entirely out of character.

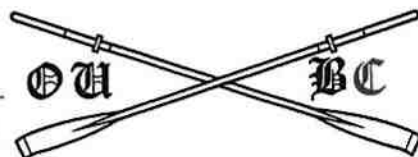

Henley crews; September training camp; 0th week trials; erg tests; the first cut to 24; small boats works; erg tests; training at Abingdon and Wallingford; Head Racing (6th at Reading, 38th in the Eights Head climbing 359 places – the highest climber overall); strength tests; erg tests; cut to 16; Tideway training camp; 8 days at home (erg on 25th December optional); Trial Eights race at Henley; move to Radley; initial selection of Blue boat and Nephthys (reserve crew); dieting starts; weekends at Nottingham and London; seat racing; erg tests; weigh-ins; still dieting; crew changes; races against Abingdon School, Shiplake College, London Rowing Club, Notts County, Notts and Union, The Old Boys race; erg test; eight outings per week; six land training sessions per week; efficient, organised and inspiring coaching from an unpaid team who will be back for 1995, two of whom are World Champions (Headed by Chris Jones with David Hardy, Bill Potter, John Pilgrim-Morris, Tim Waters, Richard Lyndon-Morgan, Robin Williams, Colin Barratt, Ian Wilson, Jock Wishart and Anu Dudia); important help from the dietician, Jacqueline, the psychologist, Charles and the physio, Andy; new equipment provided by Sponsors Ernst & Young, the accountancy firm; a 14-strong President's advisory committee (including Steve Royle from the OUBC, Mike Pelham from the OUBC Trust Fund, 3 past Presidents and three old boys) to give guidance and direction; squad parties, dinners, fraternising with the womens' squads and the annual squad dinner to make the sacrifice bearable; rowing trips abroad (in '94 to Barcelona where we beat RUBC, IC 2nd VIII and Cambridge); a strong reserve crew called Nephthys to provide spares, competition and a solid base for next year (cheers lads! – James T., Jon Udders, Jon Arse, Dave Tinker, Lucky Doug, Ed Psychopath, Seb Uber-Alles-Jones, Twotone and Fran).

The photograph on the opposite page is the product of the system the OULRC has which is only barely outlined above. In 1994 that system provided the fastest ever Lightweight crew in the twenty years of the Lightweight Boat Race. It beat the fastest ever Cambridge Lightweight Crew by 2 seconds, crossing the line three quarters of a length up in a time of 5 mins 35 secs, taking 4 seconds off the course record. Having gone down off the start, the win was the result of a devastating push at Remenham that Cambridge could find no answer to. In 1994, the OULRC prevented a second successive Cambridge rowing whitewash.

However, the CULRC will be back for the 21st race with a vengeance. With that in mind, the new President, Jon Hall (Exeter), is already preparing the groundwork for the 1995 Boat Race. If you are 12 and a half stone, if you can pull like a b\*\*\*\*\*d and if you want to win a boat race, get in touch with him as soon as you can (even if you can't row this summer but want to trial in October).

Finally, on a personal note, thanks to everyone who has helped me as President over the past two years, especially Chris, David and the eight others who crossed the line with me. If it took a year's training for each second that we crossed the line ahead of Cambridge, it was worth it. Well worth it.

Trials began in Michaelmas term 1993. The initial group of 24 triallists showed a greater depth of experience than in previous years, including four returning half-blues. Also returning for a second year was our chief coach, national squad oarsman Ben Hunt-Davis.

The squad was rapidly reduced to 16 and we spent a hard Michaelmas term slogging up and down at Godstow in two evenly matched eights. Much time was spent in the OUBC rowing centre at Iffley Road building squad strength and fitness.

This hard work was seen to have paid off when we selected provisional 1st and 2nd crews at the beginning of eighth week. With coaching from Leander cox Guy Jackson, both crews began to move. 9th and 10th week were spent training in Henley. At the end of this training camp the first crew raced an OUWBC trial crew over the Henley races course and won by a comfortable  $2\frac{1}{2}$  lengths, we went into the (v. short) Christmas break on a high.

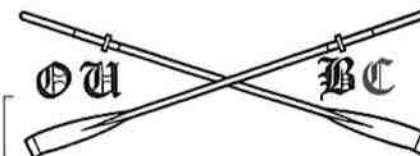
Training resumed in early January with all 16 triallists returning for another Henley training camp until bad weather forced a move to Wallingford. At the end of first week the final eight plus spares was selected and we returned to St Edward's School. The crew were more experienced and considerably larger than previous years (with a few obvious exceptions!).

Throughout Hilary term we trained at Godstow coached by our star team of Ben Hunt-Davis, Pete Roberts and Dot Blackie. Race experience was gained against the Blue Boat, Osiris, City of Oxford and Wallingford R.C. We returned to Henley in 5th week to gain more experience on the race course. In Henley we had our first encounters with Pat Sweeney of Leander, ex-OUBC head coach. Pat taught us to 'F\*\*king pull 'arder!' something which made a lasting impression on the crew...

Going into the final week at Henley there was a feeling that the crew was going well and had basic speed. Pat Sweeney returned to finish us, which gave us confidence. We went into the race feeling in control (thanks to Chris Jones for our crew relaxation) knowing that we had done as much as we could.

Conditions on race day were perfect. Cambridge were quicker off the start and took an early lead, but we knew our strength lay in hitting our rhythm and basic speed. We hit it well and past Upper Thames we began to draw back. From here on in it was closely fought. Blades clashed but we managed to maintain our rhythm thanks to exceptional coxing by Tara Fitzgerald. Going into the last 500m we were level, I think we took the lead at some point before Temple Island but none of us registered much except the confusion after we crossed the line, Cambridge cheering and shouts from the bank that the umpires were looking at a photo finish. They gave it to Cambridge, margin one foot. We felt perhaps a dead heat would have been fairer. We didn't deserve to lose on the line.

The 1994 crew wish to thank their coaches Ben, Pete, Dot, Pat and Guy for all their time and dedication. We particularly want to thank Ben Hunt-Davis for everything he has done for us for the past 2 years, he has transformed the club and given us much to build on for next year. *John Taylor,  
The Water Poet  
(1580-1653)*

Long before rowing was a sport and colleges had boat clubs, Oxford, with its complex of rivers and flood relief channels, was a centre for aquatic activity. Professional watermen congregated here, and twice in the 17th century they were joined by the bard of their trade. John Taylor, the "water poet", a moderate versifier but a real eccentric and perhaps the first Oriel man to show an aptitude with the oar.

Born in Gloucester, Taylor was apprenticed in his youth to a London waterman. In 1596 he saw action with the Navy at Cadiz: it was still customary for watermen to serve the summer months with the fleet (at 5s 9d a month). But apart from this annual opportunity for adventure – not something that appealed to all – a waterman's life was dull and unrelenting: his charges were fixed by a statute of Queen Mary's reign, and his trade was declining, now that a theatre newly built on the north bank obviated most people's need to cross the river by boat. Still, Taylor enjoyed it:

The watry Element most plentiful  
Supplied me daily with the oar and scull,  
And what the water yielded, I with mirth  
Did spend upon the Element of Earth.

But his quick facility for mediocre versification, combined with a head full of original schemes, presented Taylor an alternative: undertaking unusual or risky voyages, and chronicling them in rough and ready rhyme. It turned out to be lucrative.

Not all his writing was of this sort. He wrote a splendid work on all the types of alcoholic drink to be found in different parts of the Kingdom, pride of place naturally going to "the unparalleled liquor *Ale*, with his abstract *Beere*;" he compiled epigrams and nonsense verse, some of it in the Utopian tongue ("Nortumblum callimuquash amystolston quashte burashte..."); and he engaged in much controversial writing, expatiating for his fellow

watermen on the iniquities of travel by carriage. When the Rebellion came, he was a steady Royalist. But his best writings relate to his journeys: and the best of these to his water-borne trips. He made several of these, the longest being from London to York in a "very merry wherry", i.e. a sculling boat.

His oddest aquatic exploit, however, was the voyage he and one Roger Bird ("Hodge") made in 1619 from London to Queenborough on the Kentish coast, in a brown paper boat, using two stockfish lashed to canes as oars. They set off one Saturday evening, having publicized the project well as usual, and full of aspiration. But, predictably, it soon emerged that all was not well:

The water into the paper being got,  
In one half hour our boat began to rot:  
The Thames (most lib'ral) filled her to the halves,  
Whilst Hodge and I sat liquor'd to the calves.

He had foreseen this, of course:

In which extremity I thought it fit  
To put in use a stratagem of wit,  
Which was, eight bullocks' bladders we had bought,  
Puffed stiffly full with wind, bound fast and taut.

It was, however, only a temporary measure. Within three miles the vessel's bottom was in shreds. She continued to take in water at an alarming rate, and they feared that Gravesend really would be their grave:

Our boat drank deeply with her dropsy thirst,  
And quaffed as if she would her bladders burst.

Crowds thronged the bank but could not help, and soon night fell, leaving them cold and frightened, with no idea of their position. But at last the sun came up to reveal that they were only a few miles from the mouth of the Medway

and their destination. Clinging to the inflated bladders, they struggled ashore with what remained of the boat. The mayor of Queenborough thought to set it up as a monument to the pair's exploit, but while he was entertaining them to lunch, the townsfolk ripped it apart in their desire for a memento of the occasion: such was the destruction

That never traitor's corpse could be more scatter'd  
By greedy ravens than our poor boat was tatter'd

The major was philosophical.

Other journeys were less unconventional. In 1618 Taylor went on foot from London to Braemar; in 1620 he travelled through Germany to Bohemia. On another occasion he undertook to travel to Edinburgh without using any money whatsoever, and managed it, through a mixture of ingenuity and reliance on his own notoriety. People tended to treat him well, so scathing could his satire be if he was hard done by. On each occasion he publicised his venture well in advance, and got people to sign agreements to pay him any sum of their choosing – but not less than 6d – on its successful conclusion. He was thus a pioneer of the sponsored activity. In return he undertook to write up his journey in his inimitable verse.

And the connection with Oxford? Slight, but certain. In 1625, taking refuge from the Plague which had broken out in London, he took up residence in Oriel, under what pretext it is hard to tell. And in 1642 he came here to keep a

tavern, and was present when – much to his anguish – the city was taken by parliamentary forces in 1645. But he passed through on many other occasions, on foot or in sculling boat, and knew these waters well:

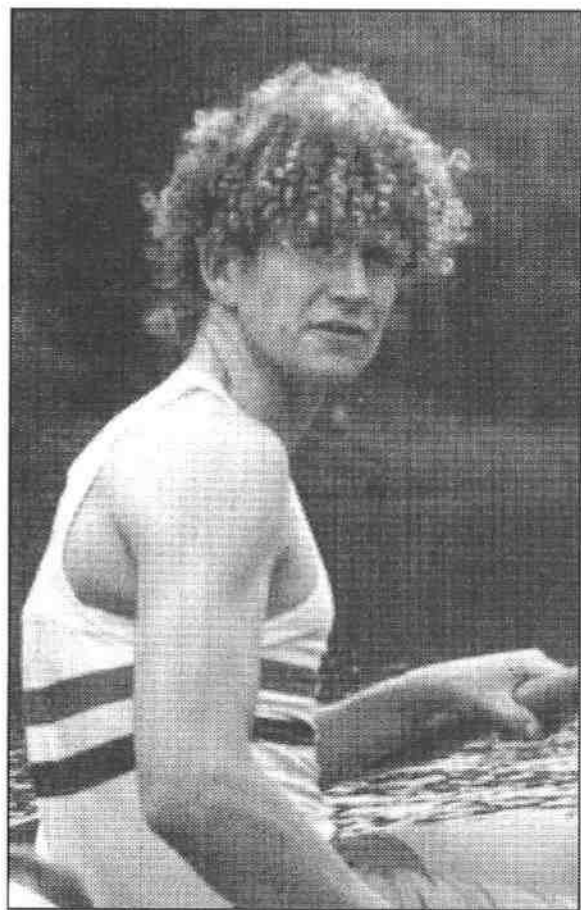
Close under Oxford, one of England's eyes,  
Chief of the chiefest universities,  
From Banbury desirous to add knowledge  
To zeal, and to be taught in Magdalen College,  
The river Cherwell doth to Isis run,  
And bears her company to Abingdon,  
Whilst very near that town on Berkshire side  
The River Ock doth into Isis glide.

Indeed, he subscribed to the view that the Latin name for the Thames, Tamesis, was a combination of "Thames" and "Isis".

Winston Churchill said rowing was good exercise but poor poetry. Acquaintance with Taylor's vast *oeuvre* would not have changed his mind. But his vivid tone and love of mad adventure assured him a wide readership. He also plays a real part in the history of rowing. Though he never raced in a boat, it seems, he undoubtedly drew attention to the pleasurable and playful attractions of river life – in today's terms, its associated leisure pursuits – and fostered the attitudes that 200 years later, with the continuing assistance of professional watermen, gave rise to the sport we know today.

1983-1994

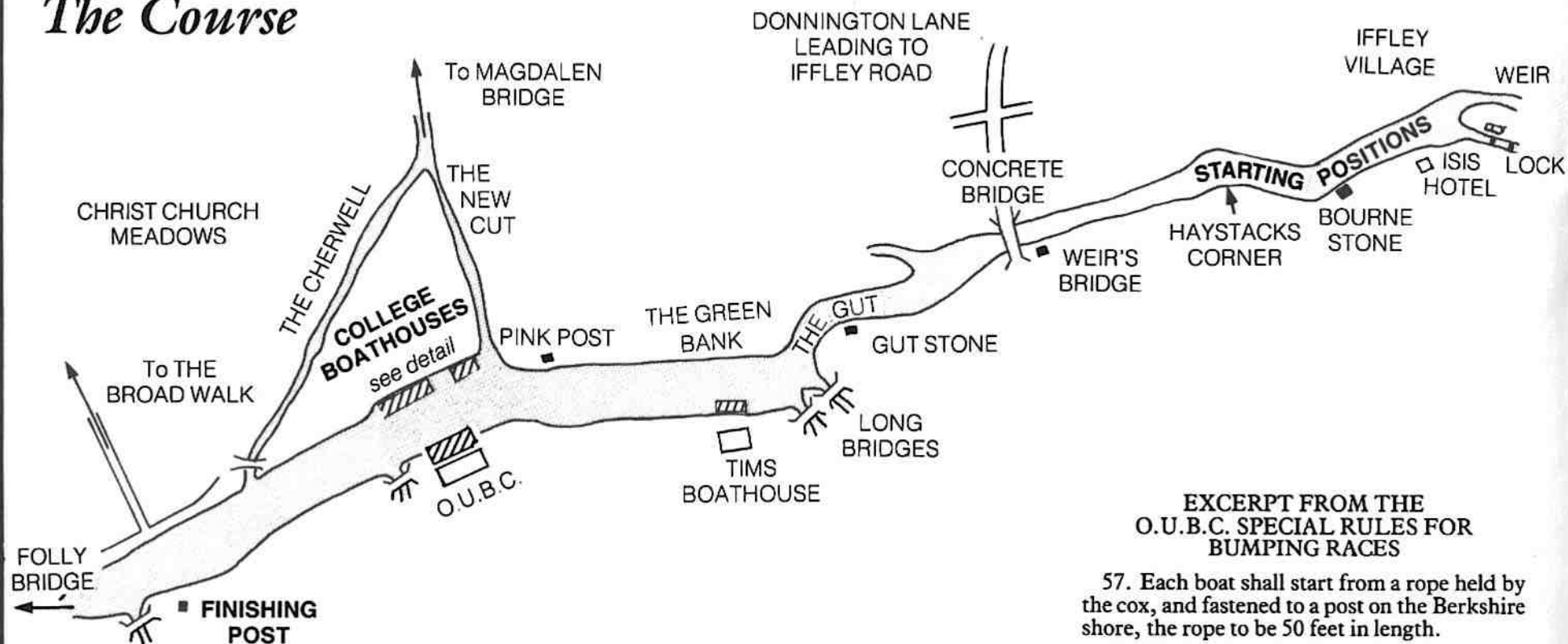




*Top Two Divisions of*

# The Course



## EXCERPT FROM THE O.U.B.C. SPECIAL RULES FOR BUMPING RACES

57. Each boat shall start from a rope held by the cox, and fastened to a post on the Berkshire shore, the rope to be 50 feet in length.

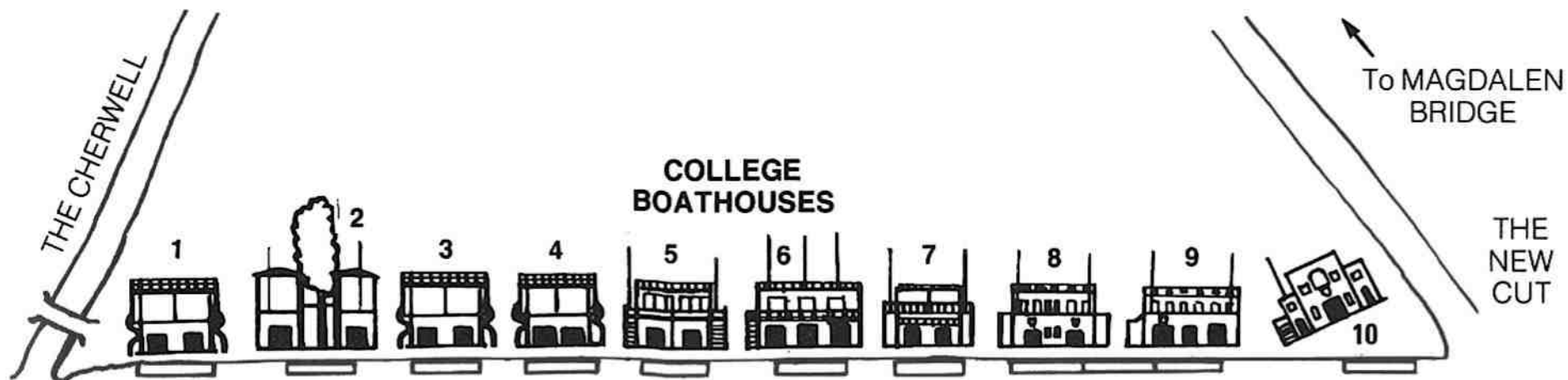
58. The last boat shall be stationed above the Starting Ring, and the distance between the posts shall be 130 feet for Eights.

65. The President shall provide a starter who shall fire a signal gun for the boats to take their places; after four minutes another gun; after the interval of one minute another gun for the start; after this third gun the Race shall always be held to have begun . . .

67. When a boat touches any part of the boat in front of it, or its oars or rudder, it shall be considered a bump, and also if a boat rows clean by another it shall be equivalent to a bump.

69. After every bump the boat bumping shall change places with the boat bumped whatever be their order before starting.
