O.U.B.C. *President's Report*

At the start of my year as President last summer a dark cloud hung over OUBC having lost the Boat Race for the fourth time and the Isis-Goldie race for the seventh time. It was clear that although we were making steps in the right direction, we were still producing crews of a less technical level than our light blue foes. Due to an understandable lack of enthusiasm Henley saw a fairly small number of OUBC entrants. However, the Cherwell Temple eight raced well through two rounds, a last-minute Britannia four reached the quarter final and the Visitors four lost in the final having lead until the last 10 strokes.

It was then necessary to spend the summer planning for a successful future and getting the most out of the various international trips. Thanks to some crucial negotiation by our Coaching Director, Dan Topolski, we managed to secure Rene Mijnders, the coach of the winning Dutch Olympic eight, to OUBC's head coaching position. We also had a run of victories over Cambridge in three different overseas regattas; by 1 foot over 500m in Cannes, by 2 lengths over 2km in Taiwan and by half a length over 17km(!) in Austria. In addition we placed Penny Chuter in the critical role of Development co-ordinator to ensure Oxford starts to produce its own home-grown talent. These were all good omens for the coming year.

We were very fortunate to welcome some new and talented athletes to OUBC; six new junior and senior internationals including the Olympic bronze medallist Tim Foster. There were many changes to put in place under the guidance of the Dutchman; no weights, much steady state and a single-minded focus on technique. The first indicators of progress were good, with a dominant presence at the ergo championships both over Cambridge and everyone else. The Fours Head yielded three category victories and the fastest four in the event; it looked as if we may have had our noses ahead of Cambridge.

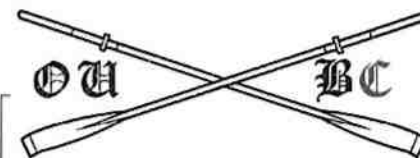
In January, to coincide with the first time the Thames has frozen for 60 years, we spend 2 weeks in Seville on a very productive training camp, where everyone produced unmistakable improvement. We then spent a further 4 weeks trying out various combinations until arriving at the final line-ups at the end of February. Unfortunately, I was not included in the Blue Boat which unusually contained no returning Blues, the decision being fair, albeit a little disappointing. I therefore rowed in the Isis crew and both crews trained for the final month prior to the Race: the only difficulty being the complete lack of able and willing opponents wishing to do combat on the Tideway. To overcome this the Blue Boat took up the Heineken Challenge in Amsterdam – 4 races over 250, 750, 2000 and 5000 metres respectively. They won the event, beating the fancied French national eight with 6 Olympic medallists on board, and a Dutch eight containing several of the recent Olympic champions.

The final week on the Tideway went well for the Blue Boat and we were widely praised in all the press reports. It was a very different story for Cambridge, who were derided in every broadsheet and were also defeated twice by Goldie two days before the race, causing them to make three position changes.

On the day, Goldie beat Isis by 6 lengths. As they had proved against their Blue Boat the crew had a fast start which we were unable to match. They were 2 lengths up after 2 minutes but only took another 4 in the next 16 minutes.

The Boat Race was an epic encounter. Oxford, on Surrey, set off calmly and relaxed planning to slip away from their opponents around their large advantageous bend. They were almost 3/4 of a length ahead at Hammersmith bridge, however, the Cambridge cox was out to spoil any advantage or rhythm Oxford produced and was repeatedly warned throughout the race. Cambridge hung on around that big bend and were level at the bandstand; at which point, and with the rest of the advantage theirs, they rowed away to win by 2 lengths. Oxford, considered by many to be the fastest crew in the world at the time, had been beaten by an inspired Cambridge crew in a contentious race.

Much has been said since about the Race and the year. I personally am convinced that we are on the right track and we did many more things right than wrong. It is unimaginably difficult to reverse a losing streak in the Boat Race, and there are a few more changes that are required in Oxford to pull this off, most notably identifying the University's raw talent to feed next year's Isis crew and the Blue Boats in future years. Rene Mijnders is around for at least another year, he is looking for talent! I hope that the University can rise to this challenge.

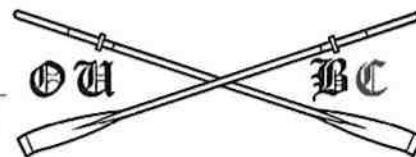
Women's Blue Boat & Osiris

After the disappointing results of the 1996 Varsity Races OUWBC had to spend time reassessing its approach. To this end a new coaching team was appointed. Ben Hunt-Davis Chief Coach, Doc Blackie in charge of land training. Ben Hunt-Davis team included some experienced and respected coaches – Sean Bowden, Russ Thatcher, Garry Herbert, Matthew Pinsent, John Peters, Sid Rand, AB. We sent 4 development squad crews to Women's Henley as well as a coxed four made up of girls from that years Blue Boat which reached the semi-final.

After this training resumed in September, with a trip to Delft Regatta and then a 2 wk pre-term training camp. The training camp was very beneficial for a rapid improvement of technique and fitness. Once term began we settled into the routine of 6 water and 5 land sessions a week, our efforts were rewarded when at Wallingford Head in December we won Senior One and Senior Two Eights.

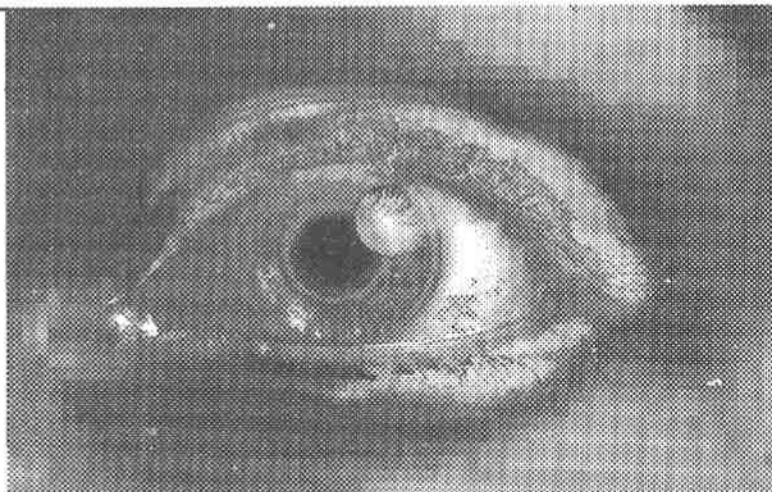
After a two week break over Christmas we returned for a residential training camp staying at Fawley Court in Henley. Unfortunately the river was frozen so we trained in London for a week! Once term started final crew selection was made and we settled down to training in our crews. Nearly every weekend of Hilary term we trained at Henley, so by the time we arrived there for our final weeks preparation, we felt like we knew the river there back to front. The final weeks preparation went very well for both crews, the Blue Boat being coached by Ben Hunt-Davis, Osiris by Matt Pinsent. On race day Osiris had the "race of their lives" going down by $\frac{3}{4}$ length off the start moving on Cambridge all the time to lose by $\frac{1}{4}$ length. The Blue Boat also had a good race but lost by $1\frac{1}{4}$ length to Cambridge. Obviously these results were very disappointing but set in the context of OUWBC over the past years they mark a big leap forward in the right direction. I do believe that our coaching team has been proven, that it is the best team that we could have and that next year we will turn the tables on Cambridge.

Could you make the difference? Last year we began with a squad of 24 (which obviously isn't ideal) and made 2 very fast boats out of it. I would encourage all womens rowers and coxes (male or female) to trial whether over the summer, or next term, or both. We need you; but speak to any of this years rowers and they will tell you what a massively rewarding experience rowing for Oxford is. Make sure that you are a part of the 1997/8 squad, the one that turned the tables, the one that made the difference.

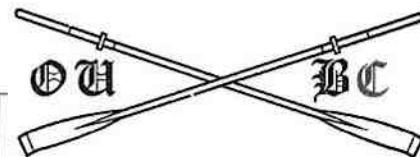

Summer Eights 1996

Eights Week opened with the prospect of **Oriel** regaining the headship lost to **Pembroke** the year before. Generally acknowledged to be the fastest boat on the river, and including the stroke and cox of the Blue Boat and the stroke of Isis, **Oriel** fulfilled expectations and bumped **Pembroke** just on the Green Bank. The Headship was defended with ease by **Oriel** for the rest of Eights. Other blades-winning crews in the first division were **Magdalen**, who included a thrilling bump outside the boathouses on **SEH**, and **New College**, who raced for barely five minutes over the four days of racing.

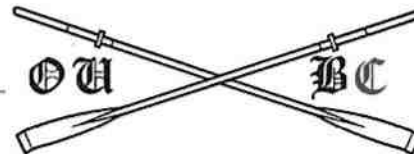
A surprise was provided by **Keble**, who, despite having a boat composed almost entirely of OUBC members (stern four all being 1996 Blues), bumped only twice. **Balliol**, having fallen sharply in Torpids, were unlucky to go down every day in Eights. **LMH**, one place up from the foot of the second division, was the only crew to row over every day, despite having overlap in the gut on **Oriel II** on the last two days. On the Saturday **Oriel** confirmed its dominance of the Isis by easying not only outside its own boathouse, but outside that of **Pembroke** also.

In the women's divisions, **Osler-Green** rowed over head every day and thus won blades. **St. Catherine's** also won blades and moved into second place behind **Osler**, promising some exciting rowing this year. In the second division, **Merton** won blades; **Wolfson** moved into the first division, narrowly missing blades in the process.

Among crews tipped as potential headship material were, aside from **Oriel**, both **Pembroke** and **Magdalen**, starting second and third respectively. In the event, there was no change in the top three positions, and after the first day, the top six positions, in the men's first division. Despite valiant attempts on all four days, **Pembroke** were unable to dislodge **Oriel** from the Head, while **Magdalen**, having been coached all year, will have been disappointed not to have moved up. **New College**, after a fine Eights performance, moved up only one place, having been held off by **Brasenose**, something of an unknown quantity this year and certainly not expected to gain a place, moving to fourth in the process. **Queen's** won blades and moved into the first division, while **Oriel II**, not content with being the only second boat in the top two divisions, moved up three places to ninth on the river. In the second division, **Trinity** and **Jesus** both won blades, **Jesus** bumping the same crew as **Trinity** each day. **Merton** joined these two in winning blades, leaving the third division in the process. **SEH II** suffered the ignominy of the greatest fall, eleven places over the four days of Torpids.

The women went one better than the men and produced no change in the top four places, despite an assault on the headship by **St. Catherine's** on the first day that must have had **Osler-Green** worried. **Osler** retained their position with rather more confidence on the following three days. **Univ** won blades and shot up five places, to fifth, while **LMH** also won blades, although with the more traditional four bumps. **Wolfson**, ending up as sandwich boat, was one of three blade winners in the second division, along with **SEH** and **Keble**. The largest fall seen in the women's divisions, as in the men's a collapse of eleven places, was that of **Pembroke II**.



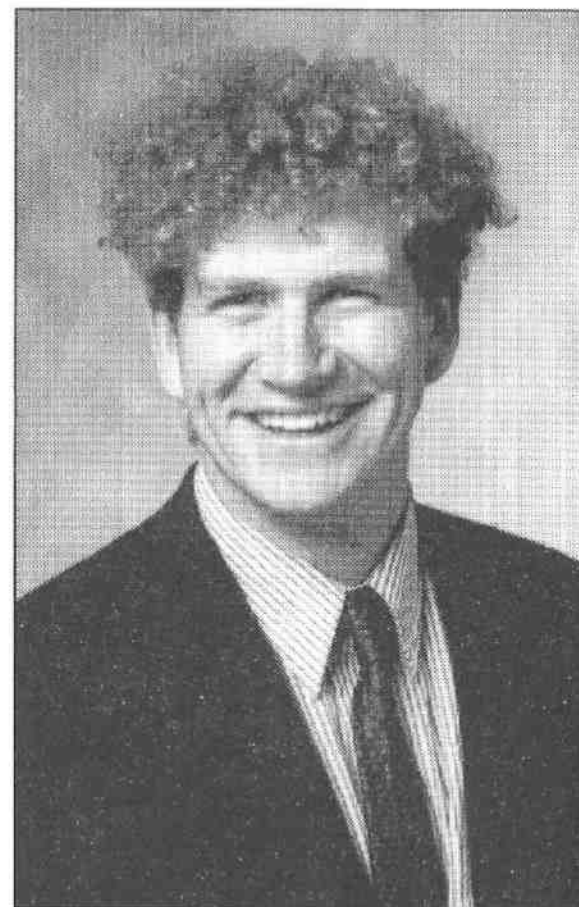

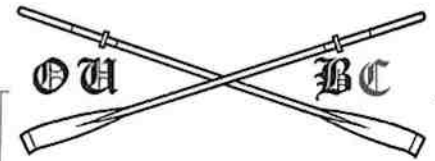

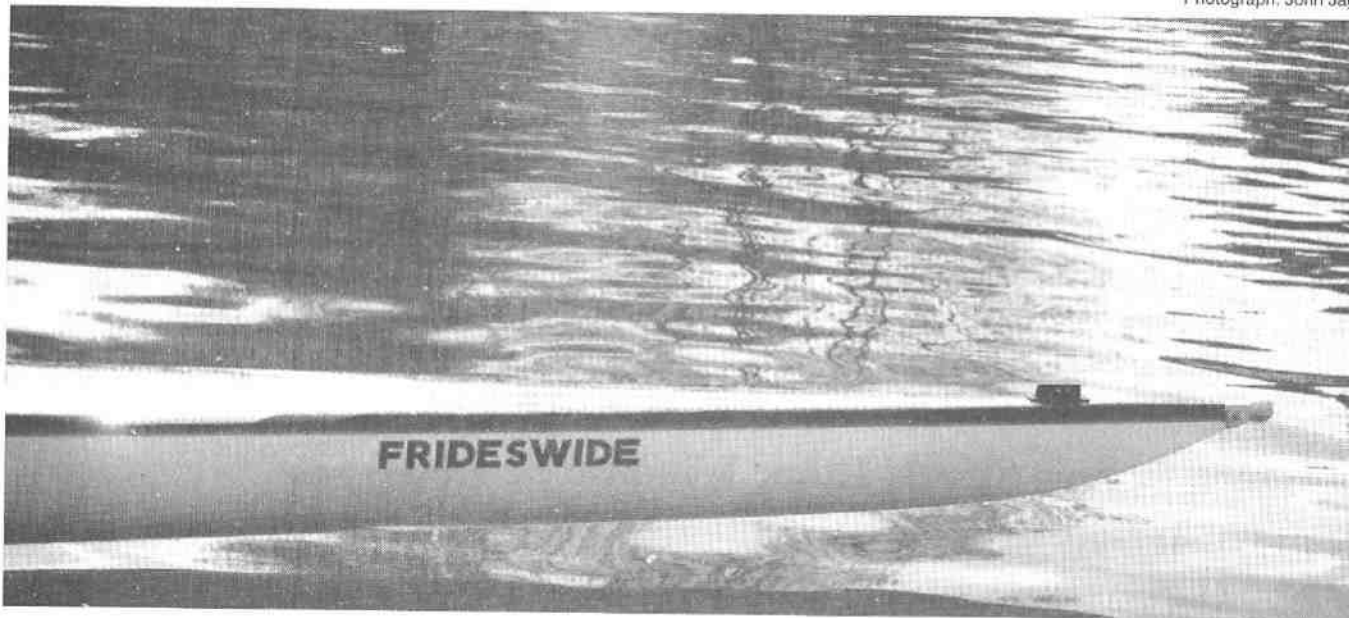
OUBC *Ferry Notice*

Between divisions, the OUBC will operate a ferry between the OUBC boat house and the lower end of the college boat houses, on each night of Eights from 12.00 noon until 20 minutes after the First Division has finished (or later if by agreement with the ferryman).

The use of the ferry is restricted to college crews, those assisting college boat clubs and those authorized by the OUBC officers with priority for the latter, and for coaches. No alcohol may be carried on the ferry. Coxes are asked to look out for the ferry and to steer clear of it. When the canoe-ferry is available, please use it in preference to the punt.

No one may operate the ferry except those authorized by the OUBC. College boat clubs are responsible for the proper use of the ferry by their members. Ferrymen have discretion in deciding priority for passengers if necessary. The OUBC thanks the ferrymen for their voluntary service.

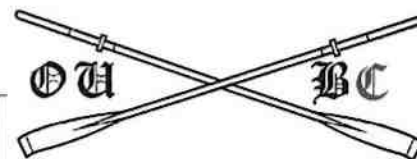
The season started off well with many wins at various Head Races. In December we had our annual training camp which was extremely successful in the sunny surroundings on Lake Banyoles, Spain. The Boat Race crew was selected early in January with a line-up containing 2 previous Boat Race winners. This years crew was without the best lightweight crew ever to be produced. This was thanks to an excellent coaching team headed by Chris Jones (London Rowing Club), Bill Potter, Rob Dauncey, Mark Lauder and Steve Royle. The race itself was very exciting. Oxford had the Berkshire station. Off the start we took an immediate $\frac{1}{2}$ length lead. Oxford underrating Cambridge all the way increased this lead to $\frac{3}{4}$ length at upper Thames. Cambridge were warned for their steering at this point and steered into Oxford causing the Oxford stroke to loose his blade for a fraction of a second. Oxford recovered well. At halfway Cambridge pushed hard decreasing the Oxford lead to only $\frac{1}{2}$ length. However Oxford very skilled and calm, still underrating Cambridge broke away to win by 5 seconds. The biggest margin since Oxford won by 3 lengths in 1992.

This is the 2nd year that the Oxford Men's Lightweight Crew has won and is the only winning Oxford crew. Mark Lauder (President OULRC 93 & 94) is now taking over as Head Coach. Oliver Kingsbury & Leila Hudson achieved a first by winning 3 times and being part of the Boat Race crew for 4 years.

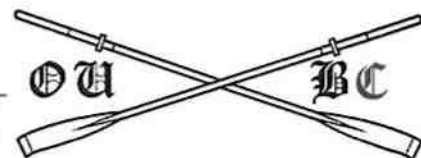
1996-97 was the first year in which OUWBC and OUWLRC were running a joint squad. The presidents chose Ben Hunt-Davis as their head coach, an Olympic oarsman who had been OUWLRC's head coach for the past few years. On his coaching team were Dot Blackie (Olympic oarswoman), Garry Herbert (Olympic Gold medalist cox), Kevin MacWilliams (OUBC boatman and ex-OUWBC head coach), Matthew Pinsent (ex-St. Catz) and A.B. (ex-GB boatman).

At the end of September we started our season with two mixed-weight crews racing at the Delft Student Regatta in Holland. Upon our return to Oxford about twenty girls trialed for OUWLRC, which included two returning Blues, Wendy McMillan and Almut Elend. During Michaelmas term the squad progressed in terms of fitness and technical proficiency. During the week we trained at Godstow and most weekends were spent at Wallingford. At the end of November two OUWLRC crews raced at Bristol University Head coming first and third in the Senior 1 category. After the end of term we went on a ten day training camp to Henley before a brief Christmas vacation.

Our pre-Hilary term training camp for which we planned to move to Henley was partly spent on the Tideway due to the Thames being frozen. After extensive seat racing and a final ergo test, the OUWLRC Blue Boat and two reserves were selected. Despite many injuries the crew started to gel together during Hilary term and gained racing experience with successful fixtures against Falcon RC, Osler House BC, a crew of Old Blues, Thames RC and training pieces with the OUWBC Blue Boat and Osiris.

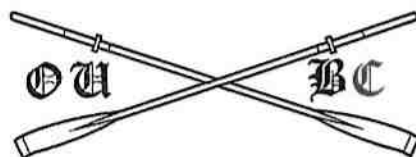
Straight after Hilary term we moved to Henley for our final Race preparation. During this week our bow-girl chose to go swimming after a collision with a German veteran VIII. Nevertheless, thanks to our great finishing coaches Dot and A.B. our spirits were unbroken. On Race Day the Cambridge crew left the blocks slightly faster, but after about fifteen strokes we took the lead and held it for most of the course. However, we never managed to extend our lead to more than three quarters of a length and with about two hundred metres to go Cambridge did their final push and managed to scrape home with a canvas lead.

This year's OUWLRC crew was one of the fastest women's lightweight crews Oxford has ever produced. Unfortunately, facing a Cambridge crew containing one old Blue, one Senior and two Junior Internationals we were narrowly defeated. My respect goes to a crew that learned to row at University – I hope you had the Race of your lives, I know I did.

- Replacement and purchase of new boats and equipment.

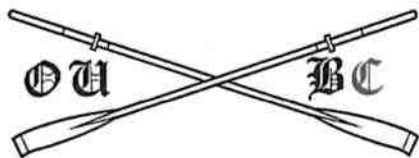

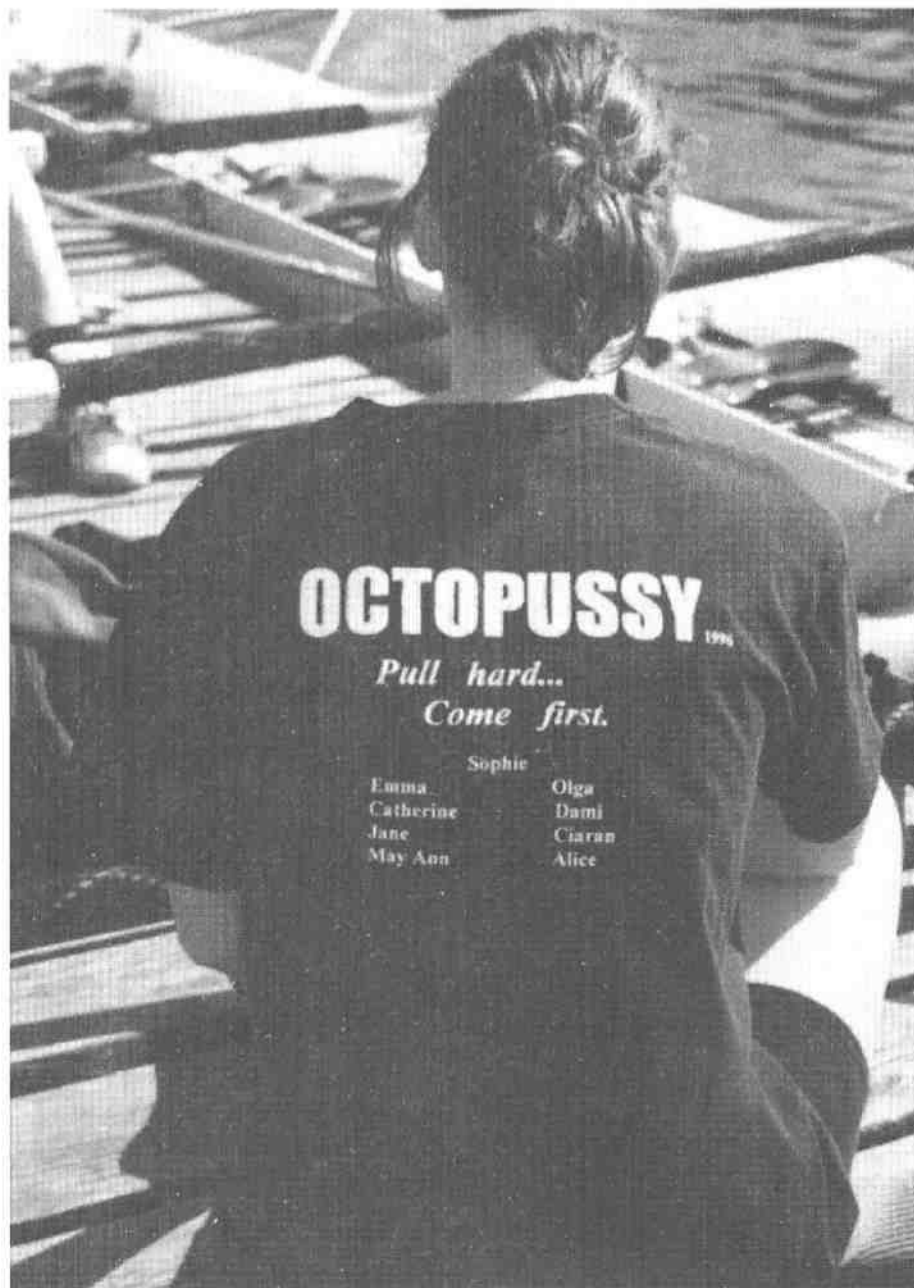

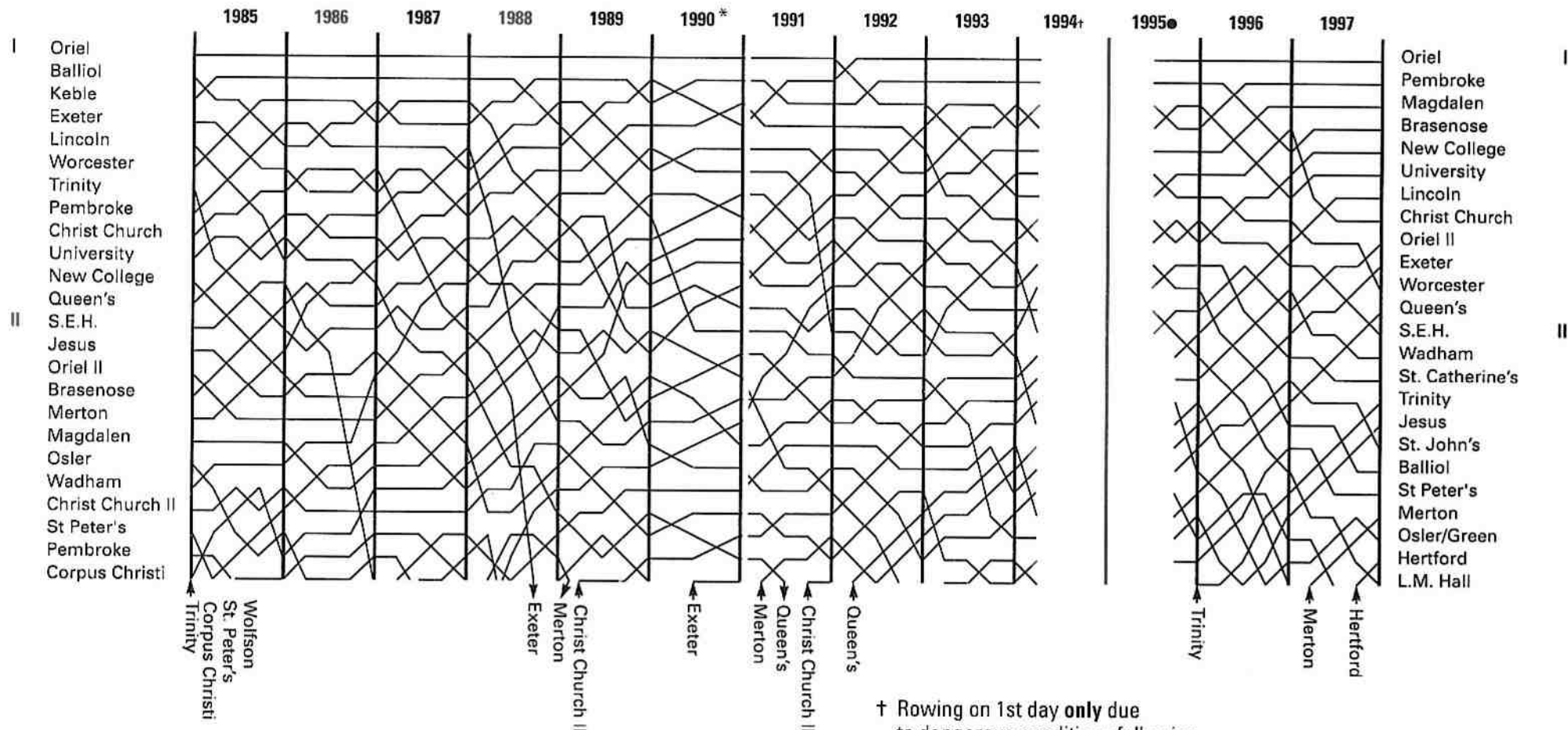

1985-1997

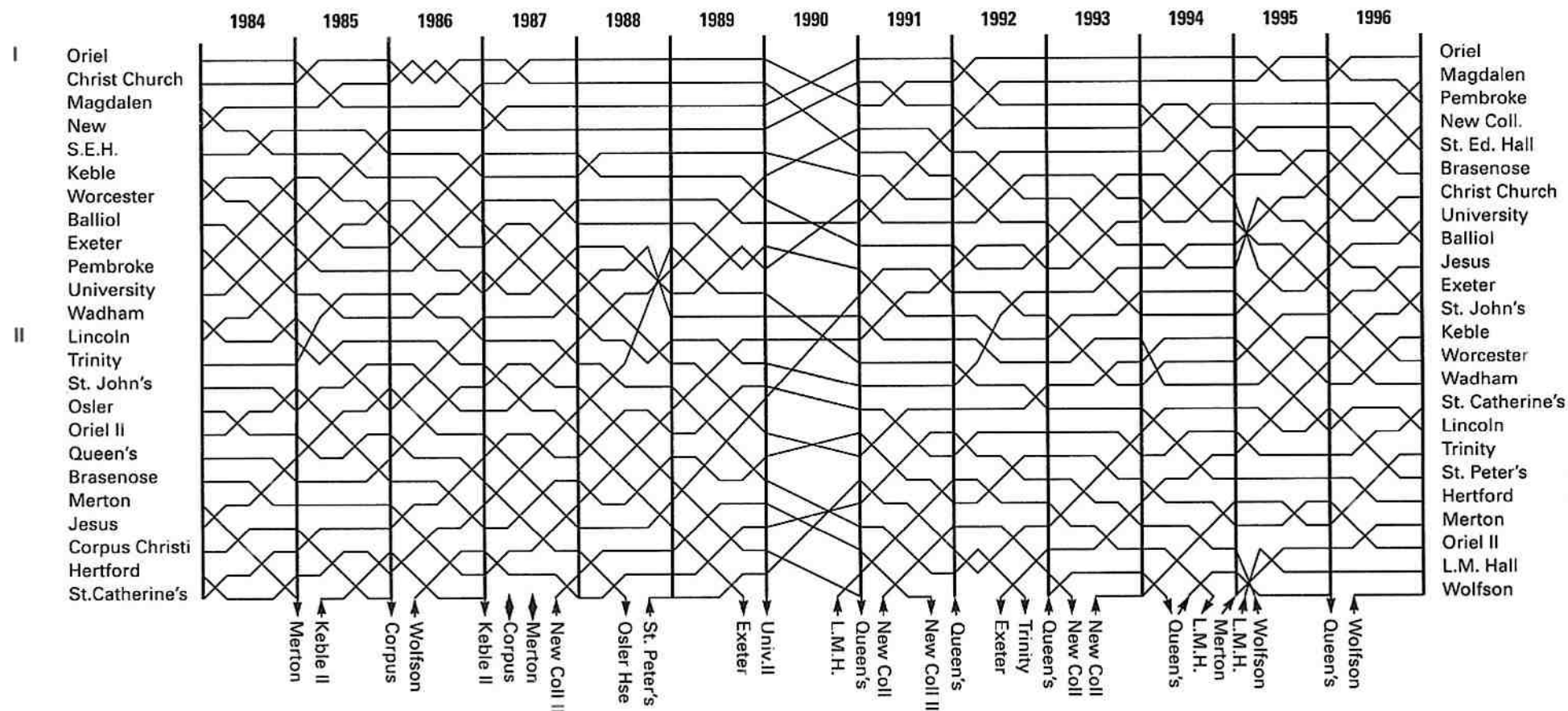

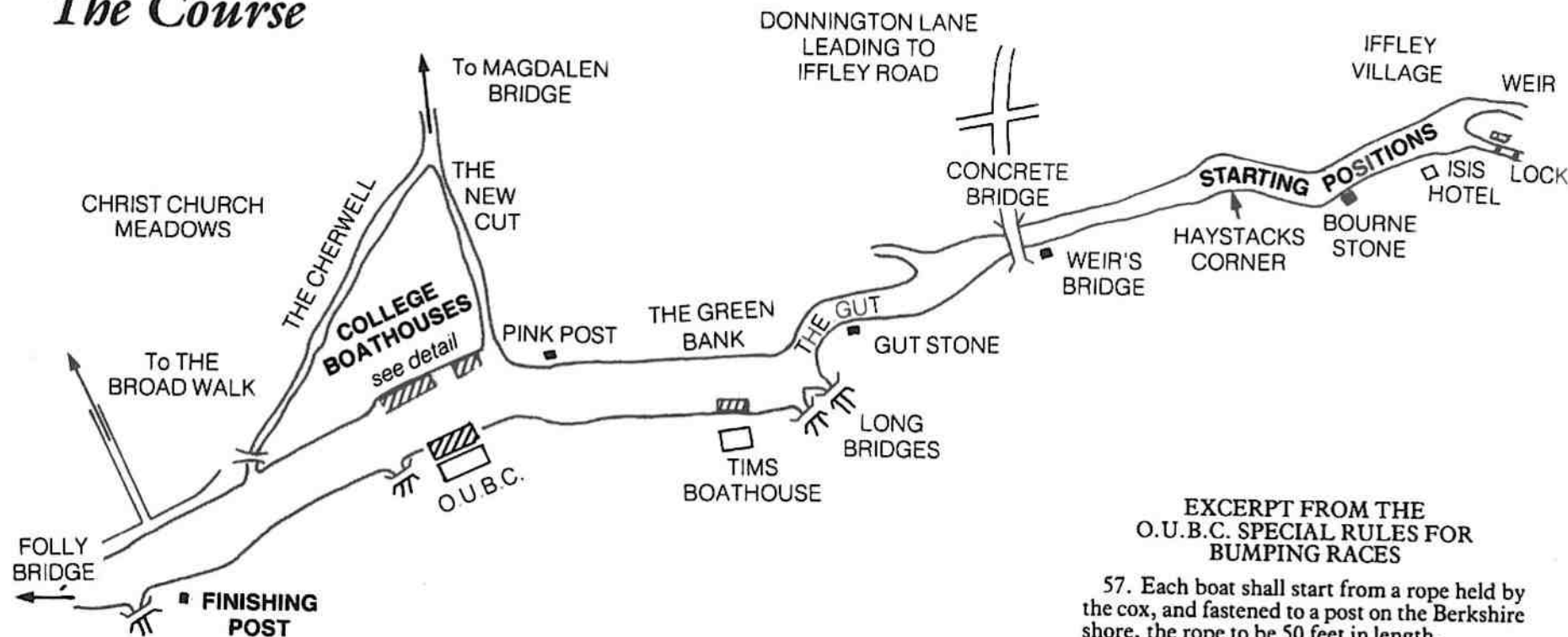

EXCERPT FROM THE O.U.B.C. SPECIAL RULES FOR BUMPING RACES

57. Each boat shall start from a rope held by the cox, and fastened to a post on the Berkshire shore, the rope to be 50 feet in length.
58. The last boat shall be stationed above the Starting Ring, and the distance between the posts shall be 130 feet for Eights.
65. The President shall provide a starter who shall fire a signal gun for the boats to take their places; after four minutes another gun; after the interval of one minute another gun for the start; after this third gun the Race shall always be held to have begun . . .
67. When a boat touches any part of the boat in front of it, or its oars or rudder, it shall be considered a bump, and also if a boat rows clean by another it shall be equivalent to a bump.
69. After every bump the boat bumping shall change places with the boat bumped whatever be their order before starting.

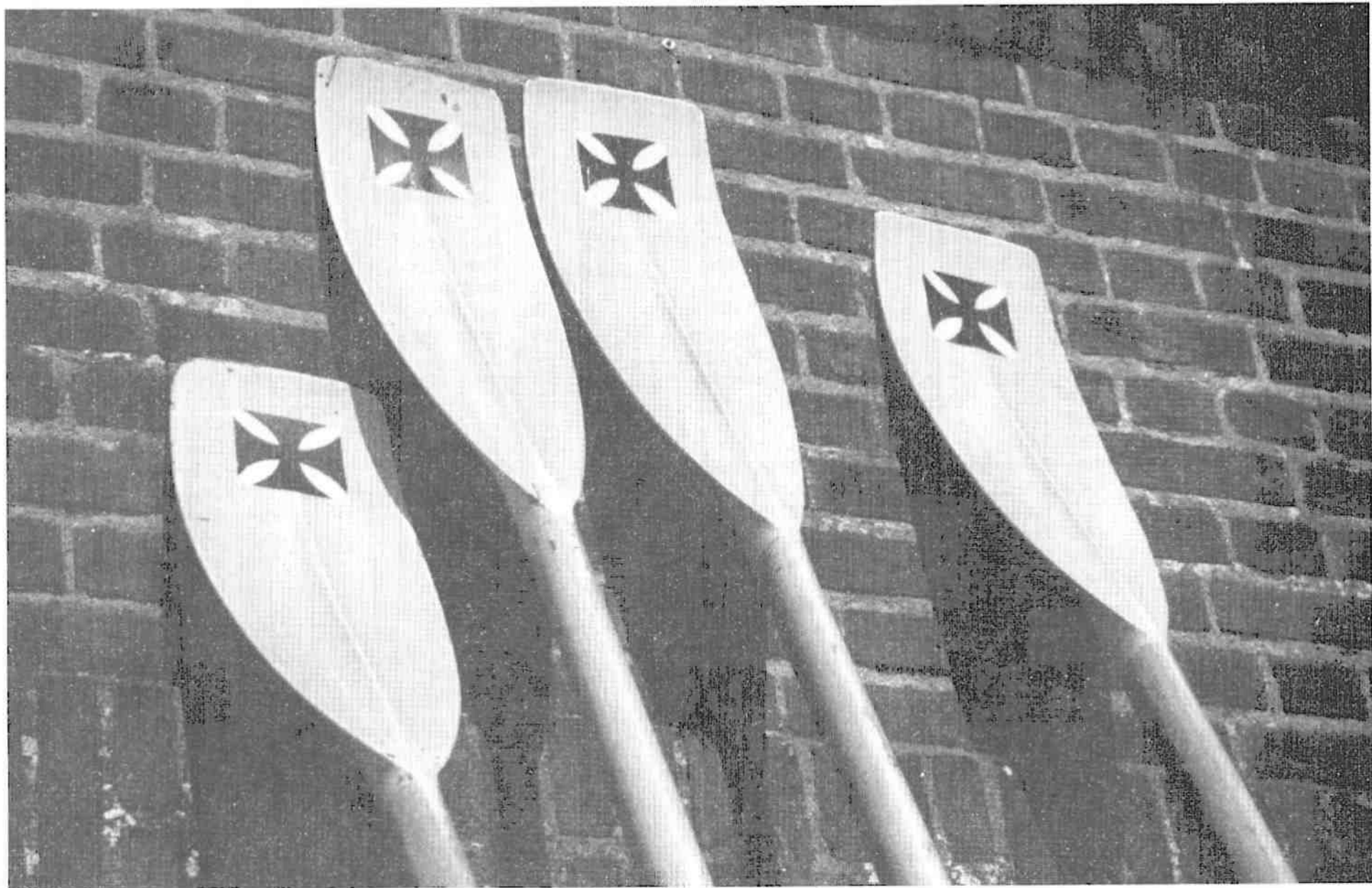
