The Trust is financed by donations from former members of college and university crews and from other friends of Oxford rowing.



The best boat race ever

On the 6th April this year John Adams, Bas Dixon, Sam McLennan, Scott Frandsen, Robin Bourne-Taylor, Dave Livingston, Henry Morris, Matt Smith and Acer Nethercott won the closest Boat Race in history. The race involved two sets of apposing brothers, a successful attempt by Oxford to turn around the biggest weight disadvantage in history and the closest margin in history, just one foot. It was a result of fantastic fun squad and their professional dedication to the cause. They trained to gain every inch of speed, and to produce it when it mattered.

Training officially started on the 2nd of September last year, and from the outset it was obvious that we would not have the supposed advantage of big guys pulling big ergs. We would have to out power the opposition using our mental and technical ability. From the first day the squad came together as we worked towards our singular goal of winning the Boat Race.

The first month's training went smoothly, but as we entered October there were signs of the difficult season ahead. We were faced with flooding which caused us to move to the short course at Eton and a number of long-term injuries and illness in key members of the squad. Such problems were taken well, and by Christmas a healthy squad of 25 was selected to go cross country skiing and to our rowing camp in Spain. Improvement was rapid, as individual and team determination to get selected and win increased our speed. Good results in fixtures showed us we had speed, but at the end of the day you only get one shot at the Boat Race and we had to deliver.

Isis started the day with a tough race, and lost to Goldie by three lengths. They were a fantastic crew without which the Blue Boat would not have produced the result it did. The Blue Boat showed incredible relentless determination from the start to the finish, and won the best race ever. It was an exciting boat to row and race in and a privilege to be a part of.

There is a huge amount of effort that goes on behind the scenes to allow the two crews to represent Oxford on Boat Race day. The coaching team lead by Sean Bowden, backed up by Jonny Singfield, Derek Clarke and Nick Howe, were outstanding this year in helping to get extraordinary performances from ordinary people. Steve Royle, Lynton Richmond, John Bell and the rest of the committee also need particular thanks and mention for their selfless help in helping to run the club. The success this year came from tremendous enthusiasm from the athletes, coaches and committee working as a team towards one goal.

With victories in three out of the last four races, the OUBC is now the wining club, and I would like to thank all of you who have supported us over the years and for your continuing support in the future. I hope this years race will encourage more people to get involved in rowing, and to put themselves forward for the 150th Boat Race in 2004. 

* denotes former Blue Boat + denotes former Osiris This year's Boat Race success, the second consecutive clean sweep for Oxford women, rounded off a season of strong squad performances. The winter season saw victories at the Pairs Head of the River and National Erg Champs, as well as top three finishes at Fours Head of the River and Wallingford Head. After Christmas OUWBC de-camped to Hazewinkel, Belgium, spending a week of intensive training with exclusive use of a 2km rowing lake (no one else was brave enough to row in the extreme cold!).

When crews were selected in early spring, preparations for the Boat Race began in earnest. Our first competition in set crews saw multiple wins at Henley IVs and VIIIs Head, followed by even more impressive victories at the Women's Eight's Head of the River Race. Here the Blue Boat placed 6th overall, beating all other universities, and earning the fastest time for University, Senior 2, and BUSA pennants. Osiris also placed in the top 20, winning the BUSA pennant for the fastest 2nd crew, meaning that Oxford had the best first and second university crews on the water!

Boat Race day, 30th March 2003, presented challenging conditions, with choppy water and a strong headwind. Going out high and hard from the first stroke, the Blue Boat proved their dominance and took an early lead. By 500 metres Oxford had taken a length from their opposition, a lead that continued to increase until they crossed the line a full 10 seconds ahead of Cambridge — one of the largest margins to be recorded in recent years. Osiris underrated and outshone their Cambridge counterparts, Blondie, settling into a long and powerful rhythm that gave them a 2-length victory and a faster time than the Cambridge Blue Boat.

OUWBC wishes to thank everyone who has supported the squad this year, in particular Rachel Quarrel, OURC, Stephen Royle, and our sponsors Baillee Gifford. We look forward to another successful season and future Oxford victories. 

After Torpids had been rained off the previous term, many crews were looking forward to the opportunity of showing what they could do. In the Mens' Division One, **Oriel** continued their dominance of the Isis, though days two and three did see overlap with **Pembroke** who were then foxed on the last day by a piece of inspired and unexpected coxing from the **Oriel** and Blues coxswain. The notable movements of Division One were the three bump rises of **Lincoln** and **Teddy Hall** and **New** dropping three places.

The women saw both Merton and New emphatically storm their way into the top three, with New winning blades in the process. Pembroke fought hard on the last day and retained the Headship. St Hilda's also made a statement with a three bump rise, and Osler-Green did the same to make amends for their two year straight drop from losing Head. 

After the disappointment last year, in which Torpids was rained off, **Oriel** defended the Headship with style and elegance, demonstrating their dominance over lesser college crews. As for **Pembroke**, an unfortunate incident with a rudder wire led to a technical drop to the second division and a broken Empacher. It was then left to **Exeter** to strive for the headship, although despite a valiant challenge, they lacked **Oriel's** finesse, remaining the second crew on the river.

Other developments in Men's Division One were Christchurch, bumped by New, Magdelen and Worcester. Brasenose managed to bump Wadham and St Catz, while Queen's rose three places from the second division, bumping LMH and Wadham.

In the women's division, **Merton** gained the Headship over **St Catz**, **LMH** fell three places and **New** fell two. As for **Oriel** women, they managed to bump **LMH**, but were narrowly denied victory over **Pembroke** due to their bow's theatrical antics on the final day.



Victory at Henley concluded another successful year for OULRC with the Blue Boat securing a comfortable win of a length and a quarter. Unfortunately our reserve crew, Nephthys, lost their rerow after a blade clash near the finish of their race; however, the performance of the whole squad was of the highest standards throughout the year.


Our first event of the season was the Fours Head in November, where all four boats entered moved up, and the top boat jumped 100 places to 98th on the river. The Indoor Rowing Championships saw the first confrontation with Cambridge, and showed that a closely fought campaign was to follow with the margin between the athletes negligible. An intensive winter training camp held at the Swiss National Rowing Centre in Sarnen was extremely productive though, and when CULRC also turned up to Bedford Head in February, both Oxford crews had a slight edge over their counterparts. Private matches tested and improved the racing mettle of the squad, and a victory against Notts County just two weeks before the Boat Race left the Blue Boat confident of its abilities.

Looking forward, the summer schedule is set to be eventful, with crews headed for Henley, France and Taiwan. The summer development squad will meet on Monday of 6th week, and those interested should look out for further details or contact the incoming President, Jeni Tod (Keble).





A visitor's guide to Eights

The college bumping races originated from outings in hired boats down the river beyond Iffley Lock. On the return, racing back from Iffley began rather casually; the first record of it is in 1815. At first, there might be only two or three boats taking part. In 1825, there were too many boats to start from within the lock and the start was made from posts along the bank 50 ft apart.

The earliest recorded rules date from 1840. Starting positions were 100 ft apart. Bumping boats drew aside from the line of rowing and changed position the next night, the first record of the word "night" being used in Eights for a day. The days of Eights are still called "nights". Eights used to be raced for six nights but are now raced for four only. The lowest divisions row first and through in order so that the first Division rows last. The boat at the head of each division is called the "sandwich boat" and rows again immediately after at the bottom of the division above it, giving it the opportunity, by bumping, to move up into that division.

Eights is under the direction of the Oxford University Rowing Clubs or OURC's. In the 1980's, the Amateur Rowing Association (founded 1882) decided to require a substantial individual subscription from every ARA member; this allowed members to participate in ARA regattas. Some colleges, those that enter ARA regattas, are members, their crews paying individual membership; others are not and do not pay the ARA subscription. The OUBC is completely independent and distinct from the ARA, though a member of it, paying its subscriptions. Of course, it is considerably older with its own rules and memberships. The OUBC council consists of the captains of every college boat club and elects the President and other officers. The OURC's is also comprised of all college boat clubs, with its own officers, but is not a member of ARA and pays no subscription to it.

Eights is organized by OURC's *College Secretary* with assistance, but with final responsibility for all of it. During Eights, operation is from the Secretary's desk positioned at the north end of the OUBC boat house. Discipline is maintained by *fines*. The College Secretary can impose fines up to £100 immediately and with no appeal and refuse, if he so decides, to let a college's boats race until a fine has been paid. Occasionally fines were frivolously imposed; but today they are usually reserved for dangerous rowing or breaking OUBC rules.


At the start of a division, each boat is accompanied by an umpire on the towpath on a bicycle to watch it. If a bump takes place, therefore, there are two umpires to observe it. At the end of the race, all umpires have to report to the Secretary's desk. All colleges contribute to the pool of umpires who umpire any boats except their own. When a division is being rowed, the centre of the towpath must be kept clear for umpires' bicycles.

Since more crews wish to enter for Eights than there is room for, places in the lowest divisions are competed for by "rowing on". In the week before Eights, these crews are timed over a course and placed in the Rowing On divisions in the order of best performance.

In the Hilary term, at the end of February, a similar event to Eights, Torpids, takes place with slightly changed rules, smaller and of less importance, partly because university crews in training are absent from college boats. The word "torpid" was first used for a non-racing boat carrying supporters and spare crew members when there was only one racing boat. Eventually these non-racing boats became college second boats and when a new event was introduced for the Hilary Term, it was named Torpids.

To avoid the main stream of the river, the customary line of rowing at the start follows the towpath bank, crosses the river at the Gut to the side of the Green bank, then returns to the towpath side between the Cherwell mouth and the OUBC rafts (see diagram of the course). Because of the breadth of the river above the OUBC, a clever steerer can steer away to avoid a faster following boat which is slowed by having to make heavy use of the rudder.

At one time, all crews used to train on the Isis between Folly Bridge and Iffley Lock in the afternoons. Now with the increase in numbers of entries and with the addition of women's divisions, the Isis is too crowded for the senior crews to train on. Many of these hire boat racks at St Edward's School at Godstow or train at Radley or Wallingford. Because of crowded work schedules throughout the day, most training now takes place between 6.00 – 8.00 am. There are perhaps fewer "rugger" boats for winter games players or "schools" boats for examination candidates; but one can still see some crews in lower divisions rowing in fancy dress.
