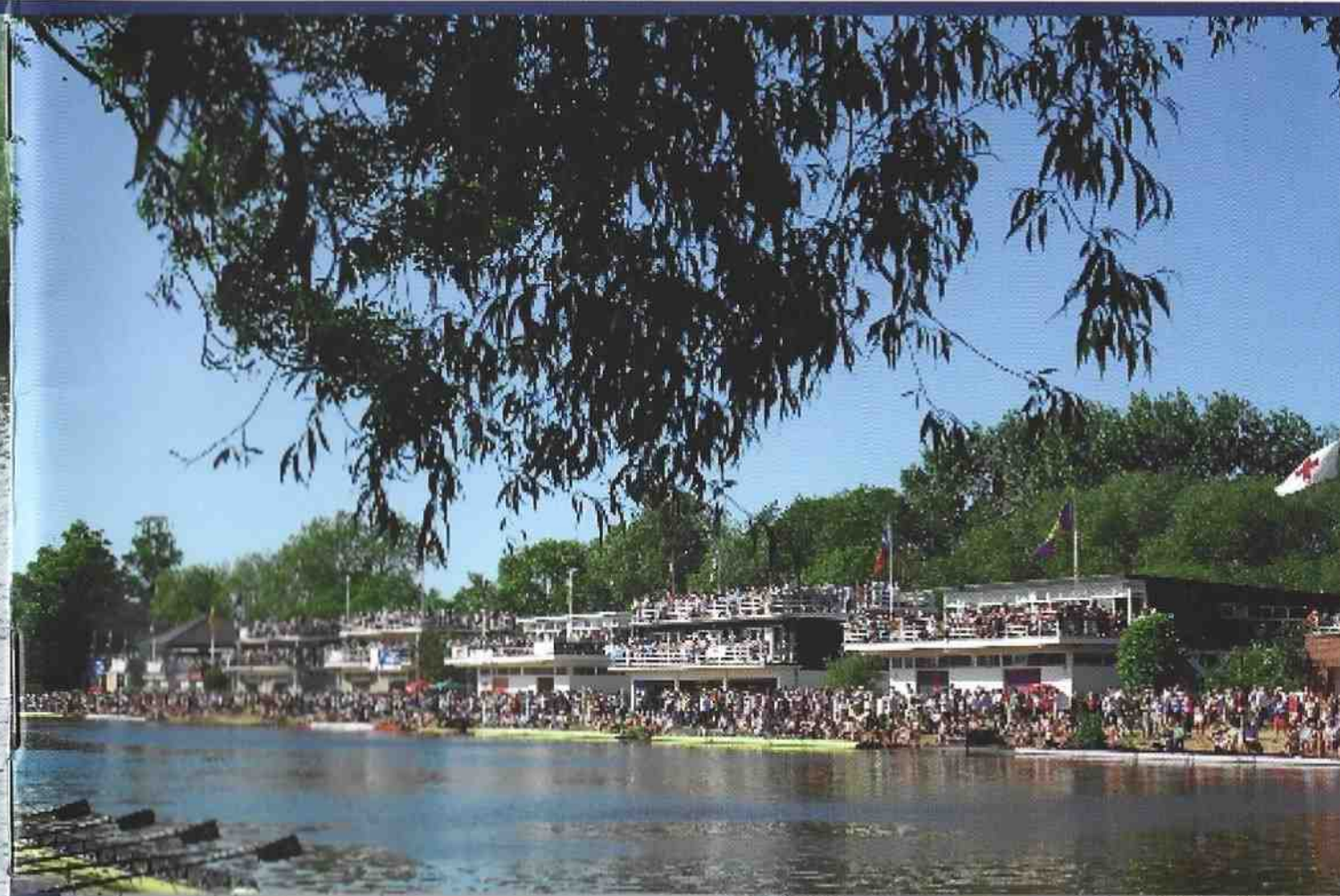

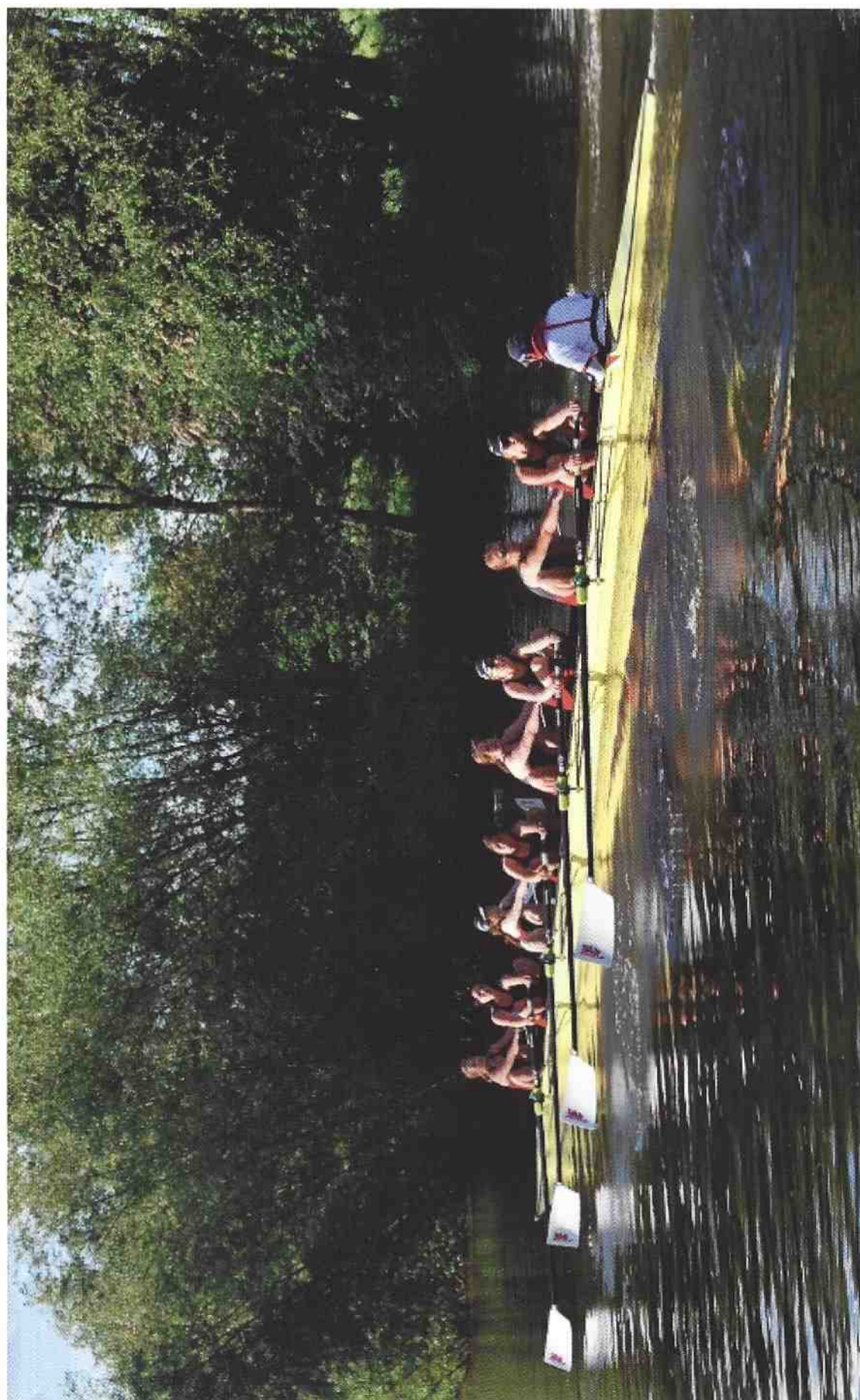

OUWBC and our reserve crew, Osiris, raced our Cambridge counterparts in the Newton Women's Boat Races at Henley on Sunday 27th March in front of record crowds. After a series of strong performances throughout the winter we knew that the Cambridge crews were going to be fast. However, over the final two weeks the boats really came together - a testament to the hard work of both the athletes and coaches. The Blue Boat had a fantastic race and beat Cambridge by one length in a time of 6:24, giving Sonia Bracegirdle an extraordinary four winning blues. I would like to thank all those who came to support us on the day and to help us celebrate afterwards.

Newton Investment Management have also generously sponsored OUWBC's summer racing, enabling us to raise the standard of our squad in preparation for the 2012 Boat Race. An initial development squad ran over the Easter Vacation

culminating in the British University and College Sport's (BUCS) Regatta on 1st May.

Two boats were entered in the competitive intermediate eight's event and both crews preformed strongly in difficult conditions. The second boat reached the semi finals and the first crew came fourth in the final, beating many established University first eights. 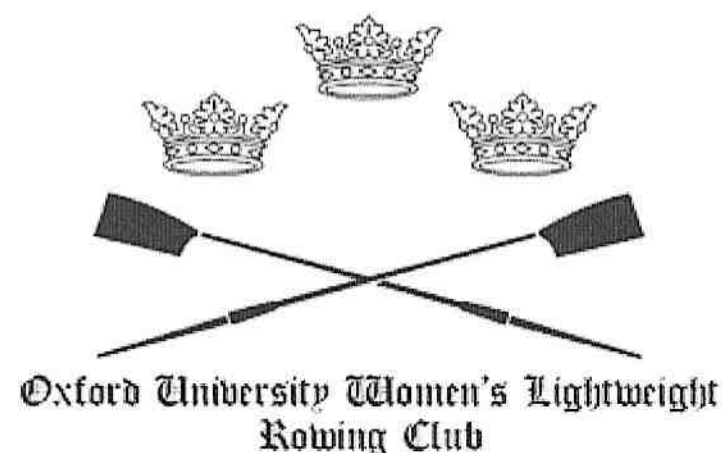

SUMMER DEVELOPMENT SQUAD

OUWLRC hopes you are enjoying Summer VILs and have had a few successful days on the water. We are running our annual summer development squad just after Summer VILs finishes, and are looking for enthusiastic rowers and coxes from all levels (W1 to W4). We pride ourselves on being a friendly, open club, where having fun is as important as succeeding in our chosen sport. There is no commitment to trialling for the 2012 Boat Race, but we are looking for talented athletes and keen rowers who might want to try out rowing at a university squad level.

Squad Dates : Monday 6 June (6th week) to Saturday 2 July (end of 9th week)

Training sessions will take place either at the OUBC Fleming Boathouse in Wallingford or at the Rowing Gym and Tank at Iffley Road Sports Centre. Transport to Wallingford will be by bus and/or car, and at least initially, you will be escorted to the boathouse by senior club members. Wallingford is a 30-min bus ride from Oxford's city centre away.

We are planning to race at **Reading Amateur Regatta, Henley Women's Regatta and Reading Town Regatta** – although we are a lightweight club, we will race in openweight events over the summer, so you don't have to be at a particular weight.

The cost for the Trinity Term Development Squad will be £50, including a high quality tech top which can be used for racing and training; and all race entry fees. Development Squad members who return to row with the club in Michaelmas Term 2011 will receive a £30 discount on their subscription.

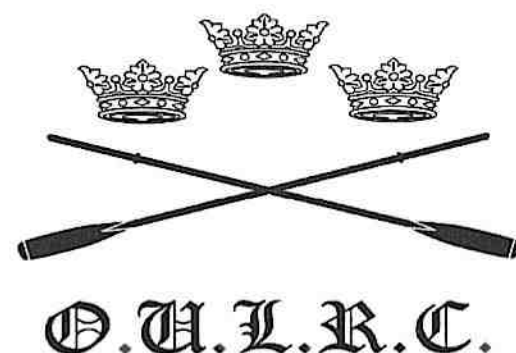

The Oxford Lightweight Blue Boat would like to thank, our Head Coach Ben Reed, and our assistant coaches Peter Nordberg and Charlie Simpson. We would also like to thank all those who trialled alongside us and fought to the end for a seat, especially Nephthys. Finally we would like to thank Cambridge Lightweights for an incredible race and we look forward to racing them again next March.



After seven months of blood sweat and tears, the Oxford Lightweight Blue Boat sat on the start-line of the Henley Boat Races course. The umpire was ready, the crowds were ready and the crews were ready.

'Oxford, Cambridge ATTENTION - GO!'

The start was simple, efficient and effective – after twenty strokes we were up two seats and after forty, up six. This was really unexpected, as we knew that Cambridge would want to break us early and would have an incredible start, but by ninety seconds into the race we were still up and were settling into our base rhythm. Cambridge was at rate 40, Oxford at 36 and moving away. We raced past the Oxford support at Upper Thames with almost clear water between us and Cambridge.

Coming up on Remenham, Cambridge upped the rate and started creeping back, more and more each stroke. We weren't fazed, however, and stayed in control; we were patient and stuck to the race plan.

At 500m to go we began our finishing sequence, and Cambridge came with us. Now both crews were fighting stroke for stroke to get to the finish line first. At 250m to go we were still up, but from 7 seat I wasn't so sure. At 100m to go we upped the rate and started to move away again but Cambridge reached a frenetic rate in the last few strokes. We were feeling the work we had put in early on, but that work had put us in a better position to win, and we crossed the line in front.

Final verdict: Oxford win by a canvas.

A brief history of bumps racing in Oxford

The details of collegiate rowing's origins in Oxford are lost in the mists of time, but the sport seems to have become popular by the end of the eighteenth century as a form of friendly recreation.

The first Summer Eights racing is thought to have occurred in 1815, a few months before the battle of Waterloo, when crews from Brasenose and Jesus decided to race home from Iffley Lock. Brasenose won, making them the first official 'Head of the River' crew. The competition became annual, racing from Iffley Lock to a finish line on Christ Church Meadow, marked by a flagpole on Isaac King's barge moored at the meadows bank.

By 1826 four colleges were involved and had devised bumping rules, the order of flags on the King's Barge flagpole indicating which crews had swapped places between race days. More colleges joined, and it was normal practice, in those days before academic league tables, for the crews to row down to Sandford in the afternoon. They would spend a while playing skittles or doing gymnastics, before rowing upstream again, with practice bursts in the stretch between Sandford and Iffley locks, to race one division. All racing stopped behind any crews which bumped, only those ahead continuing to try and achieve their own bump. Race days were interspersed with rest days, so the whole event spread out over a week.

In 1840, after high winds the previous year had disrupted racing, the current three-cannon starting system was put in place, and the 14 colleges then involved began the practice of 'bumping out' to the opposite bank, so that boats behind could carry on racing past them. By this time a parallel event, 'Torpids', had already started for second crews, initially on the days between 'Eights' racing, though in 1852 it moved to the spring term.

Meanwhile 'Eights' was becoming longer and longer, on the principle that enough racing days should occur for every boat, even that starting bottom, to be able to reach the Headship. Eventually a maximum of 8 days racing was decreed, and over time this has dropped to four. During the 1870s the 20 or so colleges competing

became split into two divisions, each crew starting 130 feet from the one behind it.

By 1908 the entry was expanded to allow second crews into Eights, and after a gap of six years for the first world war (1914-1919) racing resumed in 1920 with increasing popularity. More divisions were added, and in the early 1930s the 'Getting On Races' (now 'Rowing On') were devised to determine which crews should occupy the final slots. The formal event was again suspended for war (1939-1945), although informal bumps-style races were held, and in 1946 the event was revived using the 1939 starting order.

Although women's rowing had existed at the university since the 1920s, and some women rowed in men's crews, there were no solely women's crews in Summer Eights until St Hilda's women entered the 1969 event by successfully rowing on and competing against the men. After the all-male undergraduate colleges started admitting women during the mid-1970s, a women's division was created in 1976, with Wadham ending the first year as Head of the River. The balance of divisions between the sexes has now almost evened out, and women have been coxing men's crews, and *vice-versa*, for many years.

That isn't the only change in the last century. We now use carbon fibre boats and oars instead of wooden ones, wear cotton lycra 'all-in-ones' instead of shorts and shirts (or bloomers for the women), and in this electronic age, racing is photographed, timed, videoed, commented on and tweeted to the world. The format, however, still has much in common with those early-nineteenth century races, even if the equipment looks very different.

 "Everyone relax"
 "Remember to breathe"
 "Five seconds"
 "Four"
 "Three"
 "Two"
(pause).....
 "BANG!"

[a summary of the most alarming half-minute in the whole of your rowing career.]

Summer Eights crews start their races near Iffley Lock at the downstream end of the Oxford reach of the Thames, locally known as the Isis stretch (see map, page 37). They line up next to the towpath (southern) bank with each cox holding a 'bungline' (mooring rope with a small block of wood on the end) which spaces the crews out with one and half lengths of clear water between them. There are 13 crews per division, with the starting order determined by the previous year's finishing order.

Three Winchester model cannons set in a field near the bunglines fire blanks to signal the beginning of racing: one at the five minutes to go point, another when there is one minute to go, and the third to indicate the start. (The crew on summer bungline 6 usually has the best view of the cannons). If there is any delay to the start gun, then the sequence will be resumed from the 1-minute gun. Kindly coaches make their way round to the bunglines area, stopwatches in hand, and count down so that crews have some idea when the final gun will go off. When the start gun is fired, the coxes drop their bunglines, which are fished out of the river by boatmen, and the crews sprint off, followed by umpires to report bumps.

Earning a 'bump' in Summer Eights comes through either making contact with the crew in front

(often clashing oars), or by completely overhauling it (ie your stern passing their bow). If crew A bumps crew B, they swap places for the next day's racing. The crew at the top of each division must 'row over' (without being bumped) and then row again in the next highest division for their gender, as 'sandwich boat'. The divisions are raced in reverse order, with Women's Div 1 and Men's Div 1 the final two races of the day.

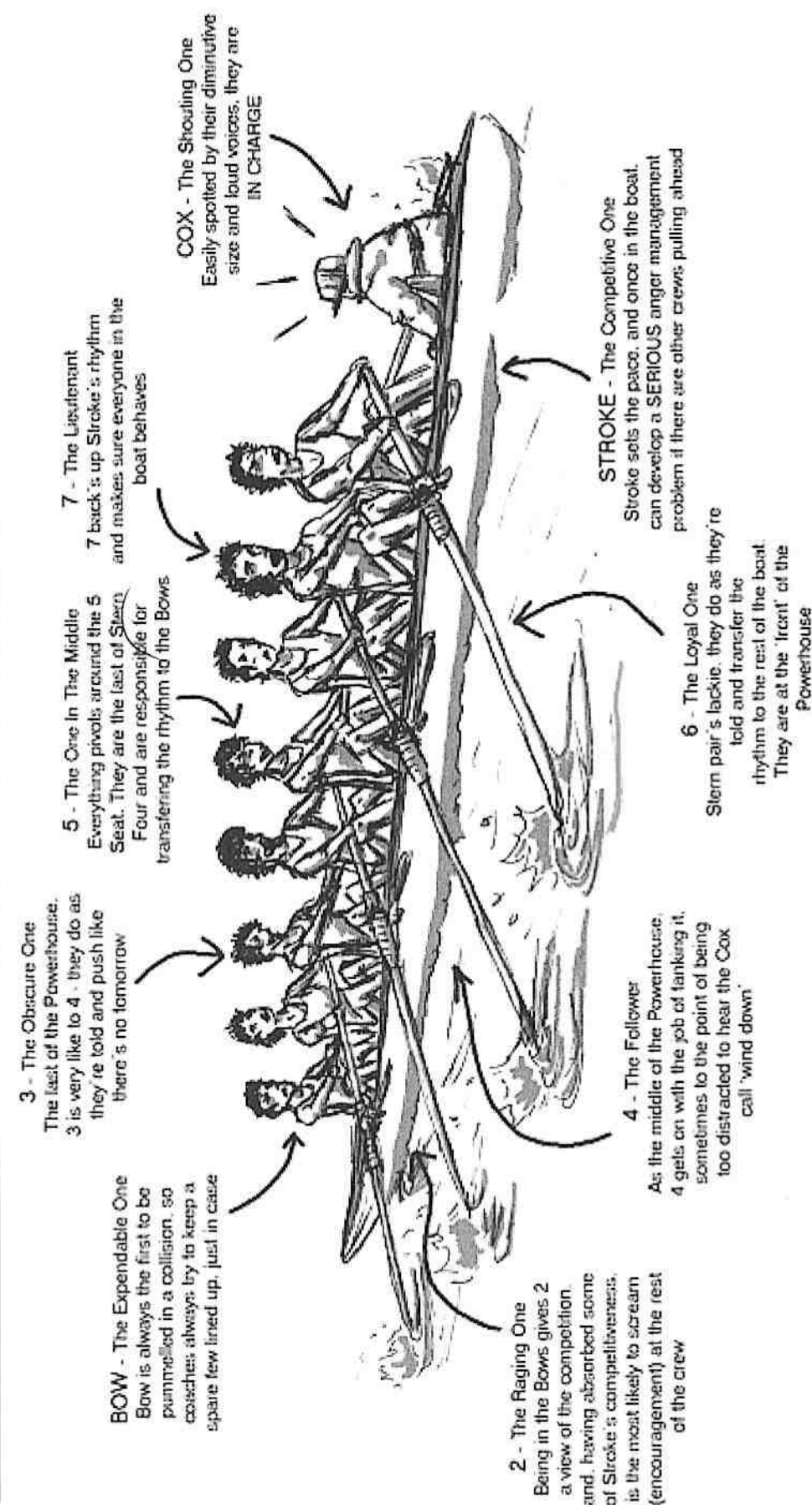
After a bump occurs in Eights, both crews drop out of the race and pull to one side to let the rest of the division continue. This can result in some 'gardening' as coxes head hurriedly for the bank. If two crews drop out leaving a large gap in the division, then it may be possible for a fast crew lower down to 'overbump' by closing the gap on those ahead. This is the main mechanism for crews to rise more than one place in a day without being sandwich boat. Equally, an overbumped crew will drop three places rather than the usual one. It is quite common for several of the boats to bump out of a division, leaving only a few rowing past the boathouses. On the other hand, a successful bump made directly outside your home boathouse crowds is considered deeply satisfactory.

On rare occasions a tangle of boats can occur, which nowadays tends to lead to a 'klaxon', when marshals fire an air-horn and stop racing completely on safety grounds. If a crew has been involved in a bump before the klaxon sounds, then it stands. Bumps achieved after the klaxon are discounted and 'technical row-overs' given. These may also be awarded if the race committee agrees that a crew was only caught due to an unavoidable external influence.

During Summer Eights spectators should see most crews three times: once as they push off to warm up for their division, once as they race past (if they haven't bumped out), and then one final time as they return to their raft. If you don't see your favourites speed heroically past, it's either very good, or very bad, news for their bumps standing.
