



Watching Eights

Perhaps one of the most exciting forms of racing; the aim of bumps is to hit the boat starting ahead of you on the river and as a result, take their place on the following day. If it becomes too unsafe (or a swan gets in the way) races will be **klaxoned** and called off. Keep track of everyone's progress with the DIY bumps charts on the next double spread and listen out for results announced over the tannoy after each division.

Glossary

Bump - when a boat catches the one in front and makes contact with it, or the coxswain of the boat in front concedes in order to avoid damage to people and equipment. Alternatively, a bump is awarded if a crew fully overtakes the crew in front. Two crews involved in a bump switch places in the start order for the next day's racing.

Headship - being the highest placed crew on the river (i.e. Bungline 1, Division 1), with no one ahead to bump.

Blades - a crew wins blades by bumping the crew ahead on each of the 4 days.

Spoons - a crew is assigned 'spoons' if they are bumped on each of the 4 days.



Summer Eights Rules

Bumps racing can be very confusing when you are new to it, so here is a small summary of the main rules to explain how it all works.

Eights shall consist of 7 men's divisions and 6 women's divisions, with the top 5 men's divisions and the top 4 women's divisions designated "Fixed Divisions", and the remainder "Rowing On Divisions".

The starting order shall be the finishing order of the previous year's Fixed Divisions.

Divisions shall consist of 13 boats, plus the "Sandwich Boat", except for the bottom division, which shall consist of 14 boats.

The boat that finishes first in each division may row as "Sandwich Boat" at the bottom of the division above in the same day's racing.

Each boat shall be started from a rope 50 feet in length, held by the coxswain, with the other end of the rope fastened to a post on the tow path. The distance between each starting post shall be 130 feet.

Not less than 5 minutes before the start of the division, the Senior Umpire shall order the firing of the 'Five Minute Gun'. 4 minutes later, or later if safety dictates, the Senior Umpire shall order the firing of the 'One Minute Gun'. 1 minute later, another gun shall be fired to signal the start.

On achieving a bump, a boat ceases to be part of a race, and the boat bumped also ceases to be part of the race.

A boat shall be liable to be bumped until every part of it has crossed the finishing line.



200 Years of Bumps Racing

The details of collegiate rowing's origins in Oxford are lost in the mists of time, but the sport seems to have become popular by the end of the eighteenth century as a form of friendly recreation.

The first Summer Eights racing is thought to have occurred in 1815, a few months before the battle of Waterloo, when crews from Brasenose and Jesus decided to race home from Iffley Lock. Brasenose won, making them the first official 'Head of the River' crew. The competition became annual, racing from Iffley Lock to a finish line on Christ Church Meadow, marked by a flagpole on Isaac King's barge moored at the meadows bank.

By 1826 four colleges were involved and had devised bumping rules, the order of flags on the King's Barge flagpole indicating which crews had swapped places between race days. More colleges joined, and it was normal practice, in those days before academic league tables, for the crews to row down to Sandford in the afternoon. They would spend a while playing poker or doing gymnastics, before rowing upstream again, with practice bursts in the stretch between Sandford and Iffley locks, to race one division. All racing stopped behind any crews which bumped, only those ahead continuing to try and achieve their own bump. Race days were interspersed with rest days, so the whole event spread out over a week.

In 1840, after a hurricane the previous year had disrupted racing, the current three-cannon starting system was put in place, and the 14 colleges then involved began the practice of 'bumping out' to the opposite bank, so that boats behind could carry on racing past them. By this time a parallel event, 'Torpids', had already started for second crews, initially on the days between 'Eights' racing, though in 1852 it moved to the spring term.

Meanwhile 'Eights' was becoming longer and longer, on the principle that enough racing days should occur for every boat, even that starting bottom, to be able to reach the Headship. Eventually a maximum of 8 days racing was decreed, and over time this has dropped to four.

During the 1870s the 20 or so colleges competing became split into two divisions, each crew starting 130 feet from the one behind it.

By 1908 the entry was expanded to allow second crews into Eights, and after a gap of six years for the First World War (1914-1919) racing resumed in 1920 with increasing popularity. More divisions were added, and in the early 1930s the 'Getting On Races' (now 'Rowing On') were devised to determine which crews should occupy the final slots. The formal event was again suspended for war (1939-1945), although informal bumps-style races were held, and in 1946 the event was revived using the 1939 starting order.

Although women's rowing had existed at the university since the 1920s, and some women rowed in men's crews, there were no solely women's crews in Summer Eights until St Hilda's women entered the 1969 event by successfully rowing on and competing against the men. After the all-male undergraduate colleges started admitting women during the mid-1970s, a women's division was created in 1976, with Wadham ending the first year as Head of the River. The balance of divisions between the sexes has now almost evened out, and women have been coxing men's crews, and *vice-versa*, for many years.

That isn't the only change in the last century. We now use carbon fibre boats and oars instead of wooden ones, wear cotton lycra 'all-in-ones' instead of shorts and shirts (or bloomers for the women), and in this electronic age, racing is photographed, timed, videoed, commentated on and tweeted to the world. The format, however, still has much in common with those early-nineteenth century races, even if the equipment looks very different.

This season the OUBC has continued its recent run of success, securing its first hat-trick of Boat Race wins since the early nineties, and winning the Isis-Goldie race for the fifth successive year. Along the way our crews took silver in open fours at the British Championships, won Elite coxed fours at the Fours' Head and took the headship at the Reading Head while also demonstrating strength in depth in the lower ranked boats. A hotly contested Trial VIII's race would provide the whole squad with invaluable racing experience on the Tideway. In their pre-race fixtures the Blue Boat took wins against Leander and Molesey without much trouble.

On the day, Isis certainly gave their coaches cause for concern at the halfway point, having conceded almost two lengths to their Light Blue opposition, but, in a fashion almost unprecedented in Boat Race history, rallied to come back from clear water down to win by some three lengths. For their part the Blue Boat produced a consummate performance, calmly moving away from Cambridge from the outside of the big Surrey bend in a testing headwind. At the end the winning margin was 20 seconds.



The Oxford University Women's Boat Club – 2014/15
 This season saw the women of the OUWBC making history as both the Blue Boat and Osiris (our reserve crew) took to the tideway for the first time to race Cambridge and win emphatically.

In October a top combination of athletes raced an eight at the Head of the Charles Regatta, Boston MA. The crew raced exceptionally to finish 4th overall, and 2nd university crew – an incredibly respectable result at such an early stage in the season and against the strength of US Collegiate Women's rowing. This result set up the team well for the next big challenge, the Head of the River Fours Race, held over the championship course. The top two coxed fours finished 1st and 2nd, some distance ahead of the fastest Cambridge crew, while our third boat, a quad, won the intermediate quad in a very fast time. The end of the Michaelmas term saw the team divided into half to race in trial eights – a close race was had over the full Boat Race course, with the crews remaining in contact until the Band Stand (1500m out from the finish).

Our new year's training camp in Saubadia was, as always, a great success. All athletes made really good progress, the crews began to come together, and some initial selection races were conducted. This set us up well for the final run in to the Boat Race, which began with both crews racing the Quinton Head – despite the freezing cold this was a hugely beneficial racing experience, with Osiris having a strong race and the Blue Boat finishing

as the highest placed women's crew in the event's history.

Both the Blue Boat and Osiris were dominant in their fixtures. Osiris over the Oxford Brooke's first boat, while the Blue Boat dispatched of strong crews from Molsey and Imperial in a similarly emphatic fashion. The Blue Boat also tested their speed against the Eton College second eight and the GB women – posting an exceptionally fast time in the latter fixture.

These results understandably gave both crews confidence heading into the Boat Race. Osiris were merciless in their approach to the reserve race, and relentlessly drove more distance into their margin over Blondie, ultimately winning with a margin of 15 lengths (45 seconds) – even more impressive given they were racing with a spare in the crew due to illness. The Blue Boat raced well, and had control of the race from the outset, going on to win the first ever women's Boat Race on the Tideway by 6 1/2 lengths.

This has been a very successful season and hopefully will be the first of many in this new and exciting era for the Women's Boat Race.

We started in September with the determined resolve that only comes from having lost the lightweight boat race the year previously. It was part of my plan for the club, when I set out as President, to move towards a full season taking in domestic races after the Henley Boat Races such as BUCS and Henley Royal, typical of other successful lightweight clubs in the country.

Around 25 turned up at the start, some lasting longer than others. During first term we took three matched crews to the Fours Head and took the Eight for a spin at Wallingford Head where we were pleased to be within 0.1s of winning our category. Trial Eights came next, in which 'Carpe Diem' beat 'YOLO' in what was a hard fought run over the race course.

By Christmas training camp we had cut our numbers down to 18 and put in a good 10 days work in sunny Soustons, in southern France. On returning to the UK we were pleased to find that this year the boathouse was not underwater, allowing us to press on with the programme.

We selected our Blue boat at the end of January, and once that was done we began a series of match races against Upper Thames, Thames RC, Tideway Scullers and Brookes that were spread over a number of weeks. The more we did, the more we learned and our final match race against the Tideway Scullers 1st VIII was honours even (this was a crew which came 10th at HoRR). We also raced at Henley Fours and Eights Head where we were pleased to win IM2 8+'s.

Coming into the last few weeks before the race, we departed for the Heineken Roeivierkamp in Amsterdam, where we saw mixed results in near freezing conditions. This just highlighted to us the strength and depth of Dutch lightweight rowing. We then stayed for a short camp in Tilburg, where we sadly had some significant illness in the crew, before returning to the UK. After a couple of days back we moved to our Henley base at UTRC to begin our last run in to the race. Conditions were tricky for most of the week but by race day we were ready. But so was Cambridge...


We were up off the start, but Cambridge gained an advantage during the middle section of the race. Despite a brave effort from our crew and an extended finishing charge, we could not quite claw back the deficit and as we clashed blades with Cambridge in the dying strokes, we crossed the line together. Devastatingly for us we were slightly down across the line and Cambridge were given a verdict of 4 ft.

Following the Henley Boat Races, we took a short break before regrouping and continuing training for BUCS. Here the standard was a step up from the boat race and in some ways we got a harsh awakening. Despite being disappointed not to medal, we gained a series of 4th and 5th places and a good standard to build on for next year. We came within a quarter of a length of Imperial for the bronze in the 8+, which in itself is an achievement we can be proud of, although it may not have seemed like it at the time.

Sitting here with another boat race loss for the club on the score card is pretty gutting to say the least. Had we been but 5ft quicker in HBR and ¼ length faster at BUCS we would have had two significant results to define our season...

As President it is especially disappointing not to have achieved the results we desired, but what we did achieve was to turn a heavy defeat in 2014 into what was so nearly a win this year and in doing so identified where we had clearly gone wrong the year previously. This gives us something solid to build on for next year. As for BUCS and the post HBR season, that is part of a 'long game' of athlete development, which we hope will reap rewards in years to come. I am confident we have moved in the right direction this year and I look forward to the next, where some of this will hopefully give us the result we desire.




OUWLRC began the season as becoming European University Champions in the Lightweight Quad last summer. Despite a notable lack of returners from last years Blue Boat, the club won multiple regional head races and performed well on the national scene at British Championships and Scullers Head, including a win in the Novice category. For the first time in many years the club also sent two athletes to the GB rowing team. After Christmas, we travelled to Coimbra, Portugal, for a 10 day winter training camp where seat racing for the Blue Boat and Tethys began in earnest. After selection, the Blue Boat competed favorably in match fixtures against some of the top Eights in the country against Molesey (6th at WeHoRR) and Headington (14th at WeHoRR), as well as undertaking a mini training camp at Wimbleball, in preparation for the Henley Boat Races. Tethys raced at Reading and Hammersmith Head, in preparation for WeHoRR and an inaugural Brookes Fixture on the Henley reach. Cambridge fielded a very strong Blue Boat this year, with multiple returners, whose experience helped them to an agonizing but well

deserved three foot victory, in one of the closest and most exciting races in the lightweight boat race history. After a devastating defeat, the Blue Boat used the invaluable racing experience to ask some tough questions and work out what it takes to win a match race where boat boats are effectively the same speed. Four weeks later, the Blue Boat produced a courageous performance to win the British University Championships, beating Cambridge by 3 seconds in the final in a memorable victory. The club followed this up with two silver medals in the Championship Lightweight Four and Quad, demonstrating the progress the club has made in sculling, the discipline required for international lightweights. The squad will again run a development squad after Summer Eights that will race at numerous local regattas, including Henley Women's, and any athletes less than 65kg are encouraged to get in touch.
