Watching Eights

Perhaps one of the most exciting forms of racing; the aim of bumps is to hit the boat starting ahead of you on the river and as a result, take their place on the following day. If it becomes too unsafe (or a swan gets in the way) races will be klaxoned and called off. Keep track of everyone's progress with the DIY bumps charts on the next double spread and listen out for results announced over the tannoy after each division.

(Note all divisions are an hour earlier on Saturday; except Men's VI & VII and Women's VI which are an hour and five minutes early)

Glossary

Bump - when a boat catches the one in front and makes contact with it, or the coxswain of the boat in front concedes in order to avoid damage to people and equipment. Alternatively, a bump is awarded if a crew fully overtakes the crew in front. Two crews involved in a bump switch places in the start order for the next day's racing.

Headship - being the highest placed crew on the river (i.e. Bungline 1, Division 1), with no one ahead to bump.

Blades - a crew wins blades by bumping the crew ahead on each of the 4 days.

Spoons - a crew is assigned 'spoons' if they are bumped on each of the 4 days.

Summer Eights Rules

Bumps racing can be very confusing when you are new to it, so here is a small summary of the main rules to explain how it all works. For more information visit: www.ourcs.org.uk/rules/a

Eights shall consist of 7 men's divisions and 6 women's divisions, with the top 5 men's divisions and the top 4 women's divisions designated "Fixed Divisions", and the remainder "Rowing On Divisions".

The starting order shall be the finishing order of the previous year's Fixed Divisions.

Divisions shall consist of 13 boats, plus the "Sandwich Boat", except for the bottom division, which shall consist of 14 boats. The boat that finishes first in each division may row as "Sandwich Boat" at the bottom of the division above in the same day's racing.

Each boat shall be started from a rope 50 feet in length, held by the coxswain, with the other end of the rope fastened to a post on the tow path. The distance between each starting post shall be 130 feet.

Not less than 5 minutes before the start of the division, the Senior Umpire shall order the firing of the 'Five Minute Gun'. 4 minutes later, or later if safety dictates, the Senior Umpire shall order the firing of the 'One Minute Gun'. 1 minute later, another gun shall be fired to signal the start.

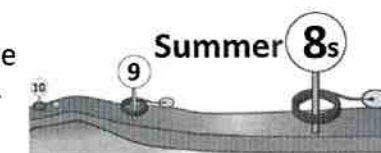

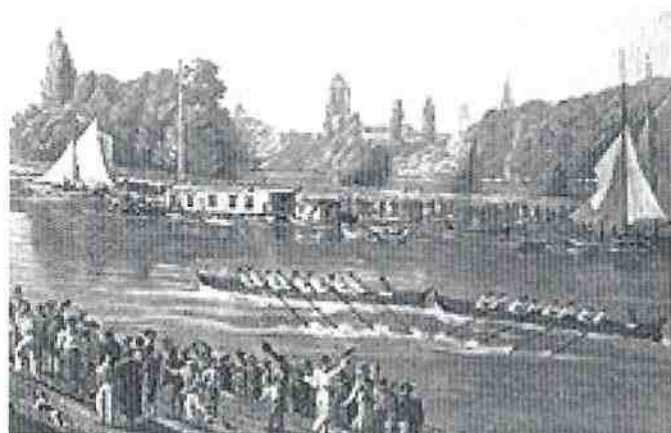
A brief history of bumps racing in Oxford

The details of collegiate rowing's origins in Oxford are lost in the mists of time, but the sport seems to have become popular by the end of the eighteenth century as a form of friendly recreation.

The first Summer Eights racing is thought to have occurred in 1815, a few months before the battle of Waterloo, when crews from Brasenose and Jesus decided to race home from Iffley Lock. Brasenose won, making them the first official 'Head of the River' crew. The competition became annual, racing from Iffley Lock to a finish line on Christ Church Meadow, marked by a flagpole on Isaac King's barge moored at the meadows bank.

By 1826 four colleges were involved and had devised bumping rules, the order of flags on the King's Barge flagpole indicating which crews had swapped places between race days. More colleges joined, and it was normal practice, in those days before academic league tables, for the crews to row down to Sandford in the afternoon. They would spend a while playing skittles or doing gymnastics, before rowing upstream again, with practice bursts in the stretch between Sandford and Iffley locks, to race one division. All racing stopped behind any crews which bumped, only those ahead continuing to try and achieve their own bump. Race days were interspersed with rest days, so the whole event spread out over a week.

In 1840, after high winds the previous year had disrupted racing, the current three-cannon starting system was put in place, and the 14 colleges then involved began the practice of 'bumping out' to the opposite bank, so that boats behind could carry on racing past them. By this time a parallel event, 'Torpids', had already started for second crews, initially on the days between 'Eights' racing, though in 1852 it moved to the spring term.

Meanwhile 'Eights' was becoming longer and longer, on the principle that enough racing days should occur for every boat, even that starting bottom, to be able to reach the Headship. Eventually a maximum of 8 days racing was decreed, and over time this has dropped to four.

During the 1870s the 20 or so colleges competing became split into two divisions, each crew starting 130 feet from the one behind it.

By 1908 the entry was expanded to allow second crews into Eights, and after a gap of six years for the first world war (1914-1919) racing resumed in 1920 with increasing popularity. More divisions were added, and in the early 1930s the 'Getting On Races' (now 'Rowing On') were devised to determine which crews should occupy the final slots. The formal event was again suspended for war (1939-1945), although informal bumps-style races were held, and in 1946 the event was revived using the 1939 starting order.

Although women's rowing had existed at the university since the 1920s, and some women rowed in men's crews, there were no solely women's crews in Summer Eights until St Hilda's women entered the 1969 event by successfully rowing on and competing against the men. After the all-male undergraduate colleges started admitting women during the mid-1970s, a women's division was created in 1976, with Wadham ending the first year as Head of the River. The balance of divisions between the sexes has now almost evened out, and women have been coxing men's crews, and vice-versa, for many years.

That isn't the only change in the last century. We now use carbon fibre boats and oars instead of wooden ones, wear cotton lycra 'all-in-ones' instead of shorts and shirts (or bloomers for the women), and in this electronic age, racing is photographed, timed, videoed, commented on and tweeted to the world. The format, however, still has much in common with those early nineteenth century races, even if the equipment looks very different.

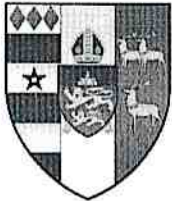

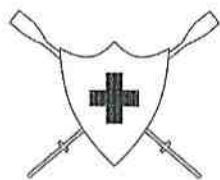

The 2016-2017 Boat Race season was one capped off by two tremendous wins for the Blue Boat and for Isis. On the 2nd April both boats took to the water against a Light Blue squad that backed themselves as one of the best in recent memory. The chat before the day was that Goldie was particularly fast. Suffice to say it was an illusion that was paid short shift by Isis around the Hammersmith bend. They worked Goldie back from almost a length down to win by 2 ½ lengths demonstrating the grit and determination that has led to seven consecutive Isis wins. The Blue Boat's race was a similar race of tactical nerve, hard pushes and coxing initiative. We took a strong lead off the start that the Light Blues reduced to ¼ length by the milepost. A clash and a well-timed push put us a length up by the apex of Hammersmith, a lead that more or less stayed the same as the two boats exchanged heavyweight blows. The season nonetheless had its ups and downs. An early visit to Brit Champs put two Oxford fours in the top 3, with the top four breaking a 20-year-old national record. The Fours Head was one of more mixed fortunes for the squad. Some very positive performances from boats ranked lower in the squad, but with the top end underperforming demonstrated that we had work to do against the Light Blues but that we also had a squad of very strong depth. This depth was demonstrated in Trial Vllls when Acer took on Daniel in a race longer than the Boat Race, finishing instead at the University of London Boat House and not Chiswick Bridge. This kind of attitude to go the extra mile became the hallmark of the squad and stood us in good stead as we took on a demanding schedule of fixtures in the New Year. Isis raced and beat both UL and Brookes, the recent top two finishes at BUCS. The Blue Boat likewise beat Brookes' Ladies Plate crew, Leander and the same Nereus VIII who won the first international rowing World Cup representing the Netherlands in Belgrade. All clearly illustrating the standard of rowing at Oxford University. Both boats this year undeniably excelled in large measure due to the squad as whole and to the athletes that, while not representing OUBC on race day made a massive difference to the ultimate success of both boats. We also benefit from a rowing program that is the envy of universities around the world; the standard of coaching and support that we receive as athletes is world class. We look set for another strong season next year and I for one am looking forward to it already.

After last Summer Eights, OUWLRC ran a large and successful Development Squad, cumulating in entering an eight at Henley Women's Regatta. While part of our coaching team focused on our future triallists, returning athletes took the summer break as an opportunity to improve their sculling skills. After being selected to represent GB Universities in the Lightweight Quad, four athletes of the 2016 Blue Boat flew to Croatia, and placed third at the European Universities Games (EUSA) in Zagreb.

The 2016-2017 kicked off with two pre-season camps. A 'live-out' sculling camp at Wallingford opened to all who had registered an interest in trialling for the club, and a pre-season camp in Sarnen (Switzerland) dedicated to returning athletes and a selection of the Development Squad. Both camps were a success - encouraging squad bonding and helping to achieve a high technical standard early in the season.

Despite a slightly lower attendance as it had been in previous years, we started Michaelmas term by training in a number of different boat combinations. After some very strong fixtures against Lady Eleanor Holles School, we decided to compete at the British Championships in Nottingham where we entered a 1wt2x and an 8+. The squad kept gaining racing experience on the national scene in Fours Head, where our two coxed four challenged some of the top open-weight crews. As in previous years, we also sent two athletes to GB trials assessment.

On the 11th of December took place our Trial Eights at Henley. *Liberté* beat *Egalité* by 1 and 3/4 lengths in a time of 6.32. It was a very useful race experience for all, which included a mock weigh-in requiring athletes to hit individualised weight targets in preparation for the Henley Boat Race.

After Christmas, we travelled to Ourense (Spain) at the world-class facilities of Laias Caldaria, for a 10 day winter training camp. Although a little chillier than expected on some days, the weather was brilliant - no rain, almost no wind and sunny. Water conditions were consequently perfect to begin selection for the Blue Boat and Tethys. In the run up to the Lightweight Boat Race, both the Blue Boat and Tethys were able to gain valuable side-by-side experience from a considerable number of match fixtures against some of the top

Eights in the country including Molesey (5th at WeHoRR), Headington School (13th at WeHoRR), LEH School, Bristol Uni BC, Wallingford RC and Oxford Brookes.

Tethys performed very strongly at WeHoRR, placing 52nd out of 295 timed starters. Despite a very strong preparation, our Blue Boat were not able to perform to the best of their ability on the day, and lost the 2017 Boat Race by 3 lengths, beaten by an impressive and very experienced Cambridge crew. The reserve pair also lost, with an official result of 'easily'. There is no question that CUWBC had a particularly strong squad this year, as evidenced by the large margins in all three women's boat races. After a devastating defeat, the Blue Boat used the invaluable racing experience to ask some tough questions and sought to identify reasons for the HBR losses. Four weeks later, the Blue Boat produced a courageous performance to win a gold medal in the Championship Lwt 8+ at BUCS regatta.

To finish, I would like to thank our fantastic squad. A truly special group of people who had the grit to turn up in September and the drive, determination and passion to move forward every single day to the Boat Race. The final result was not what we expected, however, all the performances achieved throughout the season have shown that our programme remains competitive with the top lightweight programmes in the UK.

Despite disappointment on boat race day, the club has shown signs of tremendous improvement this season. September saw the arrival of Samuel Wells as the new head coach, who came to us from a hugely successful six years at Bishops Diocesan School in Cape Town. A strong early season saw wins at Upper Thames Autumn Head, and second place in the University Shield at the National Championships. However an injury effected second place finish at Fairbairns behind CULRC, meant the squad went into the training camp with a clear idea of the task ahead.

As the run up to the boat race began, an initial shaky result at Quintin head, was followed by strong performance against London, Radley, Bristol University, Nottingham University and Leander. Nephthys won the reserve 4+ race by half a length, and going into race day, the boat was moving well. Our base speed was strong, however we didn't respond sufficiently to Cambridge's fast start, and were on the back foot from the beginning.

The greatest testament to the positive direction in which the club is travelling was BUCS regatta. This year the club has managed to secure discretionary Full Blue status, with Blues being awarded to those who medal in Championship Lightweight events at BUCS. It was a bittersweet weekend, with medals missed by 0.12 and 0.18 seconds. However for the first time in many years the lightweight four qualified to compete for GB universities at the EUSA regatta in Serbia. This will provide an exciting project for the rest of the summer and hopefully help carry the momentum into the next season.

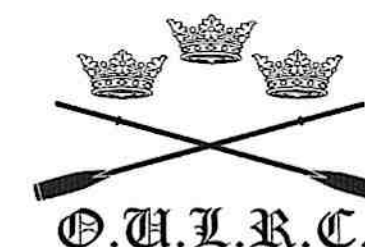
