Watching Eights

Bumps is perhaps one of the most exciting forms of racing. The aim is to hit the boat starting ahead of you on the river and as a result, take their place on the following day. If the racing becomes unsafe (or a swan gets in the way), you might hear a klaxon, meaning the race has been called off. Keep track of everyone's progress with the DIY bumps charts on pages 8-9 and listen out for results announced over the tannoy after each division.

Note that all divisions start an hour earlier on Saturday, except Men's Div V which starts 55 minutes earlier.

Glossary

Bump - when a boat catches the one in front and makes contact with it, or the coxswain of the boat in front concedes in order to avoid damage to people and equipment. Alternatively, a bump is awarded if a crew fully overtakes the crew in front. Two crews involved in a bump switch places in the start order for the next day's racing.

Headship - being the highest placed crew on the river (i.e. Bungline 1, Division 1), with no one ahead to bump.

Blades - a crew wins blades by bumping the crew ahead on each of the four days.

Spoons - a crew is assigned 'spoons' if they are bumped on each of the four days.

Summer Eights Rules

The rules of Bumps racing are intricate, and may appear mysterious to the uninitiated, so here is a brief summary. For more information, visit www.ourcs.co.uk/organisation/racing/

Eights shall consist of 7 men's divisions and 6 women's divisions, with the top 5 men's divisions and the top 4 women's divisions designated Fixed Divisions, and the remainder Rowing On Divisions. The start order of the Fixed Divisions is determined by the previous year's finishing order.

Divisions shall consist of 13 boats, plus the Sandwich Boat, except for the bottom division, which shall consist of 14 boats. The boat that finishes first in each division may row as Sandwich Boat at the bottom of the division above in the same day's racing.

Each boat shall be started from a rope 50 feet in length, held by the coxswain, with the other end of the rope fastened to a post on the tow path. The distance between each starting post shall be 130 feet.

Not less than 5 minutes before the start of the division, the Senior Umpire shall order the firing of the Five Minute Gun. 4 minutes later, or later if safety dictates, the Senior Umpire shall order the firing of the One Minute Gun. 1 minute later, another gun shall be fired to signal the start.

On achieving a bump, a boat ceases to be part of a race, and the boat bumped also ceases to be part of the race.

A boat shall be liable to be bumped until every part of it has crossed the finishing line.

As is traditional, we started with the trialling process at the beginning of September, a month before term, with a good group of about 30 rowers and coxswains. Our team this year was in general pretty young with a decent number of undergraduates and Freshers.

The first race of the season was Brit Champs, where we faced off against Cambridge in coxless fours, but fell short to Cambridge, finishing second overall. Clearly not the result we were aiming for and we trained hard for the Fours Head of the River, our second and last direct encounter with Cambridge before the Boat Race. In quite challenging conditions, with a stiff headwind, the first four managed to clinch the win but overall the team's performance was behind Cambridge's.

Onto Trial Eights, an incredibly important race, as it is the only time a full side by side race over the championship course in eights can be practised. We had a very good race, with the two boats fighting all the way to the Eyot, where the Middlesex crew was able to break through and eventually win by a length of open water.

Over term break the squad went on training camp in France, where there was plenty of calm good water to row on, and where a preliminary selection of the Blue Boat and Isis was made.



After coming back to Oxford, we moved relatively quickly onto our fixtures against Molesey/Imperial College, Oxford Brookes and Leander, spending a few weeks to get ready for racing and bringing the engines up to the required rpms. The first fixtures did not all go as planned for the Blue Boat against Molesey and Brookes, requiring several line-up changes and further selection. Isis enjoyed a better run and was ultimately a bit disrupted in their preparation but showed good spirit and determination.

Going into the Boat Race both boats built very good momentum, coming along well and determined to give it their all. Unfortunately, both Isis and the Blue Boat didn't manage to beat Cambridge on the day, but with most squad members returning and hungry for revenge, we are confident that next year will be dark blue.

- Take all other waste home with you when you leave.

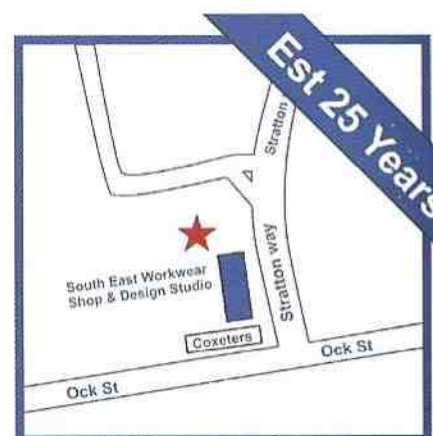

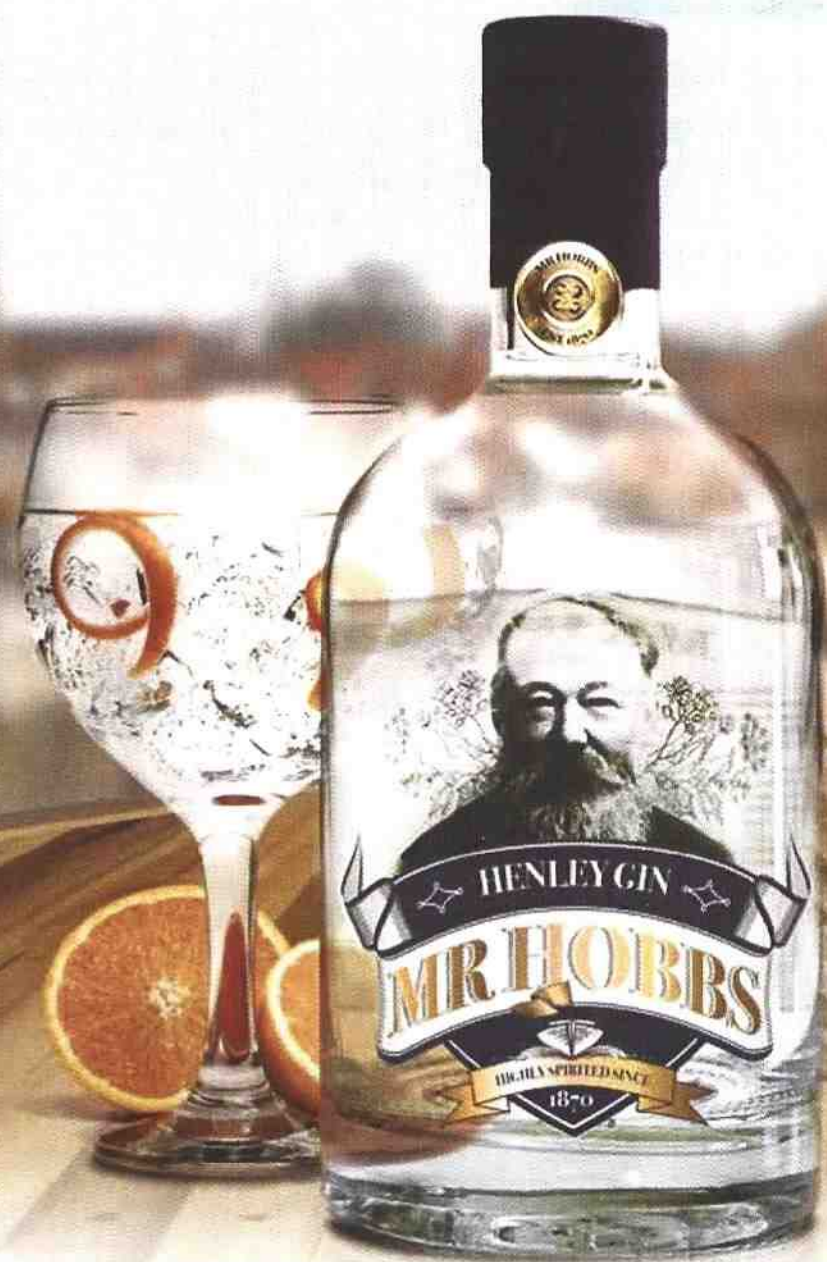

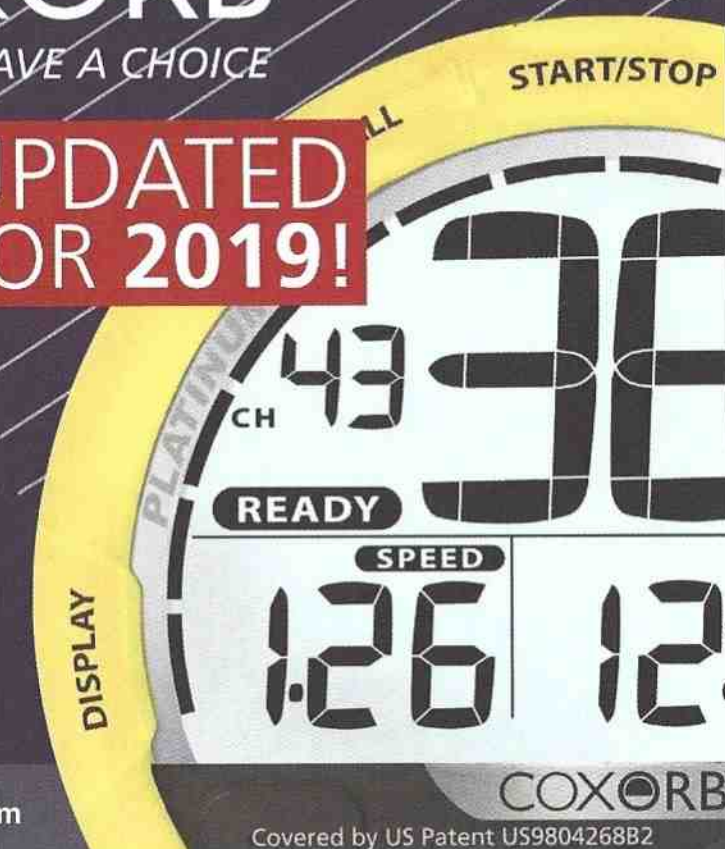

The 2018-2019 season has been a highly successful one for OUWLRC, the biggest highlight being a victory over Cambridge by 2½ lengths at the Henley Boat Races on 30th March.

The trialling season followed a well-attended development squad last summer, with 40 athletes attending regularly, and two 8+s and a 4+ racing at Reading Town Regatta. During the summer we also had returning athletes racing at Met Regatta, Henley Women's and Henley T&V. We sent a lightweight double and single to the European Universities championships (EUSA), finishing 4th and 6th respectively.

The season got underway with a training camp in Sarnen, Switzerland, which provided excellent opportunity for logging some good miles and for technical development in small boats. During Michaelmas term, we entered a number of races: notable results include a win in the lightweight quad and university shield eight at the British Rowing Championships, and a 2nd place finish in the championship academic quad and a win in the challenge academic coxed four at Fours Head. We then held a winter training camp in Ourense, where we did some valuable race work and began Blue Boat selection.

In the run up to the boat race we had fixtures against Bristol and Newcastle, both of which we won. The Blue Boat and a second eight also went to race at the Heineken Cup in Amsterdam, with the Blue Boat performing promisingly in a competitive field.

At the Henley Boat Races, we beat Cambridge by 2½ lengths in a time of 6:28. Sadly, despite putting in a gutsy performance, our reserve pair lost to Cambridge by 1½ lengths.

Since the boat race, we entered a number of boats at the British University Championships (BUCS). Notable results include a gold in the championship lightweight 8+, a silver in the intermediate lightweight 1x, and a bronze in the championship lightweight 4-. Our athletes are currently enjoying returning to college rowing, looking to chase each other down in Summer Vills!

The year was a momentous one for our Club and our race, as it was the first to be held on the Championship Course on the Tideway. We therefore approached the 2018-2019 season with high hopes of making improvements in both strength and depth. This renewed vim and vigour came off the back of some strong 2018 summer results, the height of which was a European Universities Gold in the LM4-. Coach Sam Wells returned for a third season to a strong squad hungry for a win after a narrow defeat in the Lightweight Boat Race in the preceding year.

The club has raced consistently and to a high standard throughout the season, posting commendable results at Fours Head and Quintin Head, and in several match races in Hilary Term, consistently bettering our light blue counterparts. This added to the confidence we gained throughout the season through technical improvements in small boats, and physiological improvements achieved with the help of physiologist Filipe Salbany and Ali Cigari and Wattson Blue.

The Lightweight Boat Race was a resounding success, showing that the format can be translated to the lightweights and can still provide an exciting experience to spectators, with competitive racing. The verdict went our way to a tune of 2 ¼ lengths after coming

from 1 length down off the start, in what was certainly a peak of a great season so far.

However, the season was far from done. The squad continued to train and race into the Easter break, recently winning Championship medals in each of three events at BUCS, the British Universities Championships, placing the club in the top three lightweight programmes in the country against stiff competition, and qualifying us for the European Universities Championships for two events for the third year running.

Going forwards, we are looking forward to fielding competitive crews for the remainder of summer season, culminating in Henley, closing out a great season for the Club.

Thanks go to the members of the OULRC Steering Committee and the Race Organising Committee, as well as our sponsors and supporters, who are too numerous to name individually here.

A brief history of bumps racing in Oxford

The details of collegiate rowing's origins in Oxford are lost in the mists of time, but the sport seems to have become popular by the end of the eighteenth century as a form of friendly recreation.

The first Summer Eights racing is thought to have occurred in 1815, a few months before the battle of Waterloo, when crews from Brasenose and Jesus decided to race home from Iffley Lock. Brasenose won, making them the first official 'Head of the River' crew. The competition became annual, racing from Iffley Lock to a finish line on Christ Church Meadow, marked by a flagpole on Isaac King's barge moored at the meadows bank.

By 1826 four colleges were involved and had devised bumping rules, the order of flags on the King's Barge flagpole indicating which crews had swapped places between race days. More colleges joined, and it was normal practice, in those days before academic league tables, for the crews to row down to Sandford in the afternoon. They would spend a while playing skittles or doing gymnastics, before rowing upstream again, with practice bursts in the stretch between Sandford and Iffley locks, to race one division. All racing stopped behind any crews which bumped, only those ahead continuing to try and achieve their own bump. Race days were interspersed with rest days, so the whole event spread out over a week.

In 1840, after high winds the previous year had disrupted racing, the current three-cannon starting system was put in place, and the 14 colleges then involved began the practice of 'bumping out' to the opposite bank, so that boats behind could carry on racing past them. By this time a parallel event, 'Torpids', had already started for second crews, initially on the days between 'Eights' racing, though in 1852 it moved to the spring term.

Meanwhile 'Eights' was becoming longer and longer, on the principle that enough racing days should occur for every boat, even that starting bottom, to be able to reach the Headship. Eventually a maximum of 8 days racing was decreed, and over time this has dropped to four.

During the 1870s the 20 or so colleges competing became split into two divisions, each crew starting 130 feet from the one behind it.

By 1908 the entry was expanded to allow second crews into Eights, and after a gap of six years for the first world war (1914-1919) racing resumed in 1920 with increasing popularity. More divisions were added, and in the early 1930s the 'Getting On Races' (now 'Rowing On') were devised to determine which crews should occupy the final slots. The formal event was again suspended for war (1939-1945), although informal bumps-style races were held, and in 1946 the event was revived using the 1939 starting order.

Although women's rowing had existed at the university since the 1920s, and some women rowed in men's crews, there were no solely women's crews in Summer Eights until St Hilda's women entered the 1969 event by successfully rowing on and competing against the men. After the all-male undergraduate colleges started admitting women during the mid-1970s, a women's division was created in 1976, with Wadham ending the first year as Head of the River. The balance of divisions between the sexes has now almost evened out, and women have been coxing men's crews, and vice-versa, for many years.

That isn't the only change in the last century. We now use carbon fibre boats and oars instead of wooden ones, wear cotton lycra 'all-in-ones' instead of shorts and shirts (or bloomers for the women), and in this electronic age, racing is photographed, timed, videoed, commentated on and tweeted to the world. The format, however, still has much in common with those early nineteenth century races, even if the equipment looks very different.

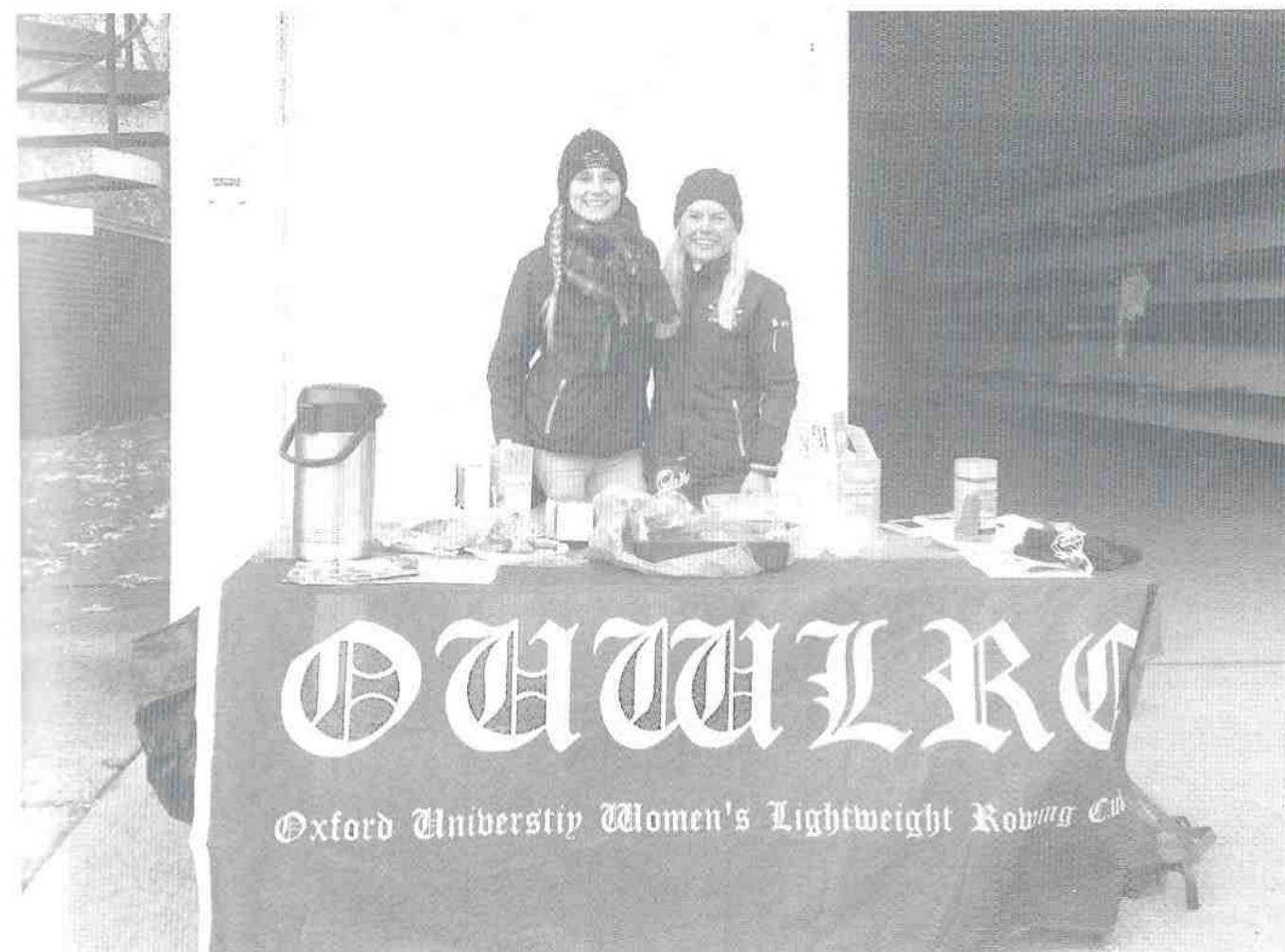
- Bring your own reusable cups and bottles, which can be refilled with fresh drinking water at the new taps that have been installed at the boathouses.
